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3 | MESSAGE FROM THE ~~PASTOR~~ DEACON

I'll bet you weren't expecting to see that heading, eh? As Fr. Ken mentioned last week, he was going on vacation and asked me if I wouldn't mind helping him to meet the deadline for this column while he regenerates.

Today is Word of God Sunday!

You probably noticed the fir trees in our churches adorned with envelopes. Those envelopes contain a scripture verse and a prayer intention (a couple might even include a \$5 bill!). Take home an envelope for your family and use it for prayer and reflection over the next few weeks (or months). See where the Holy Spirit might be guiding you. Pope Francis instituted Word of God Sunday in 2019 to focus on the importance of Sacred Scripture. The theme this year is: "The Word of God dwells among you" (Colossians 3:16).

At Mass, we not only experience Christ in the Eucharist but also in the Liturgy of the Word. We can liken the encounter with the Word of God at Mass to coming to receive communion. There is an encounter between the communion minister and the communicant at which there is an exchange—the giving and receiving of a gift, if you will. In this exchange, both minister and recipient encounter the Presence of Christ. Likewise, in the act of proclaiming and hearing the Word of God at Mass, we find the Presence of Christ in an exchange of the gift of his Word.

It has been my honor to bring the Word of God to you over these past 26 ½ years. One of the deacon's most distinct liturgical roles is proclaiming the Gospel during Mass. Regardless of who presides—whether a parish priest, a bishop, or even the Pope—it is the deacon who reads the Gospel aloud. At ordination, the bishop hands the newly ordained deacon the book of the Gospels and he says, "Receive the book of the Gospels, whose herald you have become." This act isn't simply ceremonial— it's a commissioning. The deacon becomes a living voice of the Word, echoing Christ's own mission to proclaim good news to the poor.

Advocates for Persons with Disabilities

In the next few weeks you will be hearing more about an inclusion committee of advocates whose goal will be to help guide our parish to becoming a more welcoming place for persons with special needs of all kinds. Over 20% of the U.S. population has a disability of one kind or another. Surely our parish reflects that general percentage. It's not just a matter of "getting them in the door" but also of welcoming them and identifying the gifts they may have to offer. If you have some special need or care for or know someone with a disability, please consider joining us as we look for ways to make Archangel Gabriel Parish welcoming to all. More information will be coming.

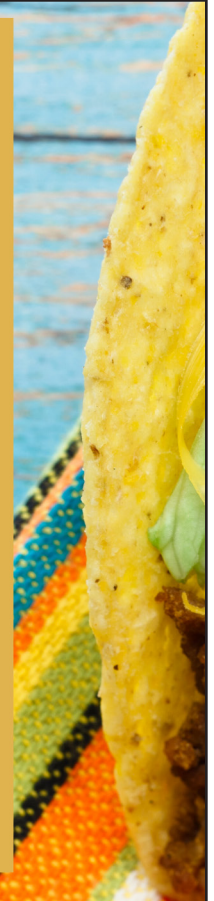

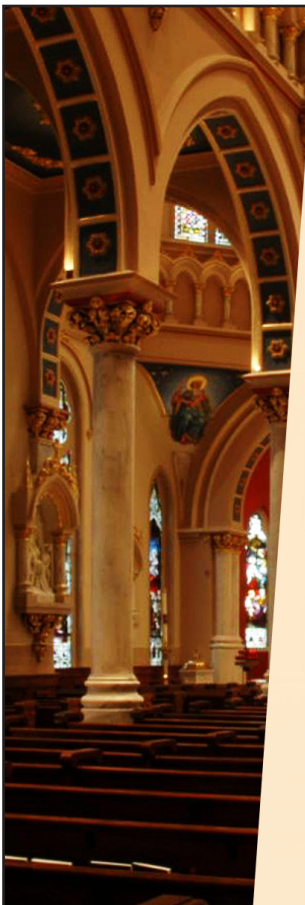
Anointing Mass

Sunday, February 15 | During 12:30 PM Mass
Holy Trinity Church

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. A person should be anointed before surgery or when a dangerous illness is the reason for the intervention. Moreover, older people may be anointed if they are in a weak condition, even though no dangerous illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by this Sacrament.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

All those who wish to be anointed should check in prior to the start of Mass at the registration table in the Narthex. You will be directed where to sit, and the priests will come to you for the Sacrament.





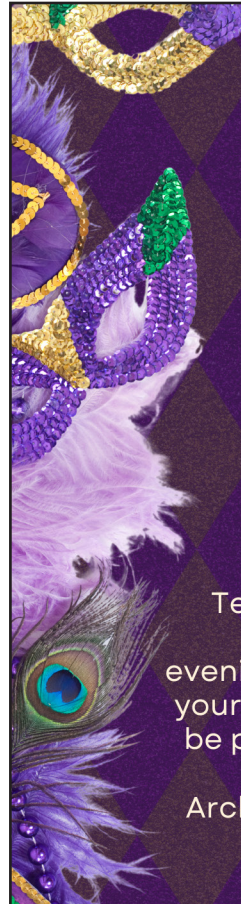

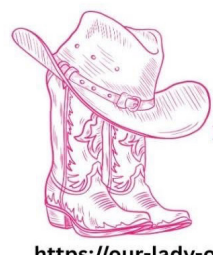
