A New Year, A New Strength, and A Little More Sweetness

New Year's Resolutions: On the first Sunday of Advent, I invited you to pick a resolution for the new liturgical year. If you are like me, you might have already failed at keeping it, but as the calendar flips to January, we are given another chance. I encourage you to pick something that truly helps you grow closer to God. For me, that means putting down the handheld electronics after 8:30 PM and picking up my Kindle; I want to read more and work less late at night. That was my failed liturgical new year resolution, but hopefully, it will be my successful calendar year resolution.

Our Parish's 6th Birthday: Iron & Sugar: Our parish was founded on January 6, 2020. Traditionally, a sixth anniversary is celebrated with Iron (symbolizing strength) and Sugar (symbolizing sweetness). I think this fits us perfectly. Iron represents a relationship forged in the fire of time that has become unbreakable. Archangel Gabriel Parish has shown its *strength* by continuing to grow and by embracing the call Bishop Zubik made when we launched *The Church Alive*

movement to "Learn Jesus, Love Jesus, and Live Jesus." It is through our people and our ministries that we show the community our *sweetness* of Christian living. We have had fun in our service to our neighbors and participating in local events and being visible in outreach ministries, bingo, and the farmer's market. We have also had some wonderful celebrations like our Pentecost lunch, the Parish Picnic, Nationality Festival, The Art of Christmas, and two oldies dances, that show the pure joy of simply being together.

From Wood to Iron: The Strength of Adoration: To mark our 5th anniversary last year, we reflected on the Wood of the Cross—the "Tree of Life" from which our salvation flows. This led us to institute our Parish Holy Hour at Saint Malachy Church on Thursday nights. Jesus chose to transform the wood of the cross into the new tree of life. From his cross comes our salvation. He has been lifted up for the entire world to see. This was prefigured in the Old Testament (Numbers 21:4-9) when Moses erected a bronze serpent on a pole so that anyone who had been bitten by a snake could look at it and be healed. I noted last year that the Church offers us the opportunity to look upon the Lord to find our own healing during periods of adoration. Pope Pius XII in his encyclical *Mediator Dei* spoke of how adoration has contributed to a deeper understanding of Christ's presence outside of Mass. He pointed out that the different forms of Eucharistic adoration "have brought a wonderful increase in faith and supernatural life to the Church upon earth." Adoration, in all its forms, is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament that occurs in every Mass. I have spoken many times of the opportunities our parish offers to adore the Lord, and I once again invite you to consider making adoration a part of your prayer life in 2026.

The Sweetness of Community: 3rd Place Saturdays: Finally, we are fully committed in 2026 to our Third Place Saturday gatherings. In sociology, your "third place" is the social space outside of home and work where you truly connect with others. We want to be that place for you—a place to gather as a Catholic Family. No one is called to walk the journey of faith alone. Our Third Place Saturdays are opportunities to enjoy fellowship and "communion" with one another. Each month we are improving the experience, offering activities from 8:30 AM - 12:00 PM, including:

- Mass & Confession
- Adoration & Lectio Divina
- Service Projects & Speakers
- Fellowship: A continental breakfast and (starting in February) a dedicated "coffee shop" room.

You, your family, and your friends (Catholic or otherwise) are invited to come for the whole morning or just one part. Let's make 2026 a year defined by the strength of our faith and the sweetness of our community.

Two new employees: You will be seeing two new faces around the parish. Darian Raithel is our new Facilities Maintenance Manager. He will be responsible for overseeing and managing all aspects of the parish's physical property and ensuring that all buildings and grounds are safe, clean, and well-maintained for liturgical and community use. The position involves a mix of hands-on work and administrative duties. Cecilia Grace Burchill has also been brought on in an internship-style position as the Associate Organist and Music Ministry Assistant.

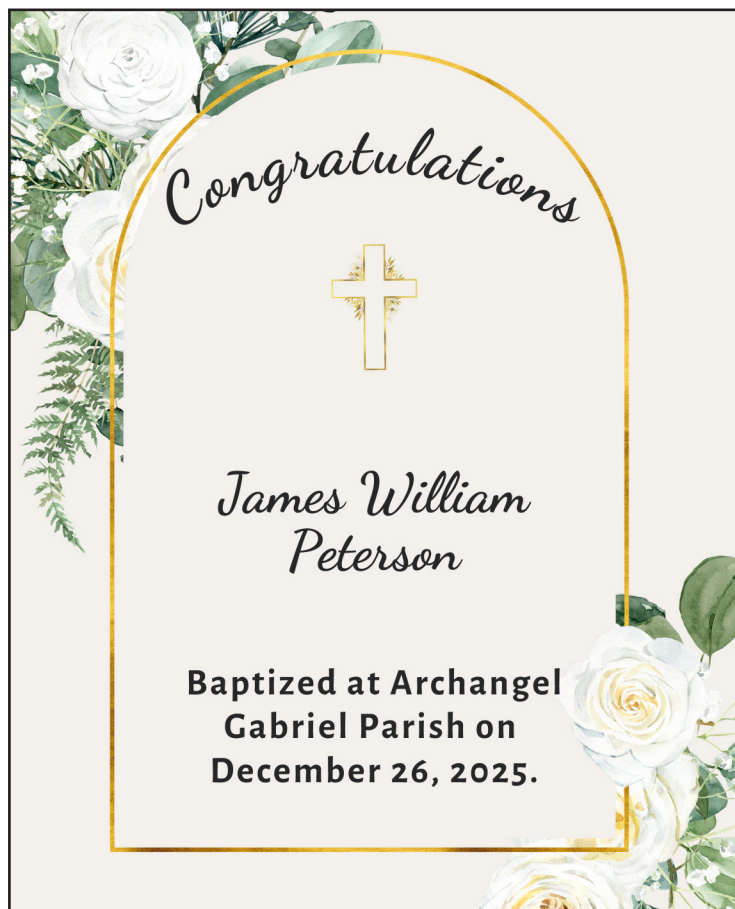
