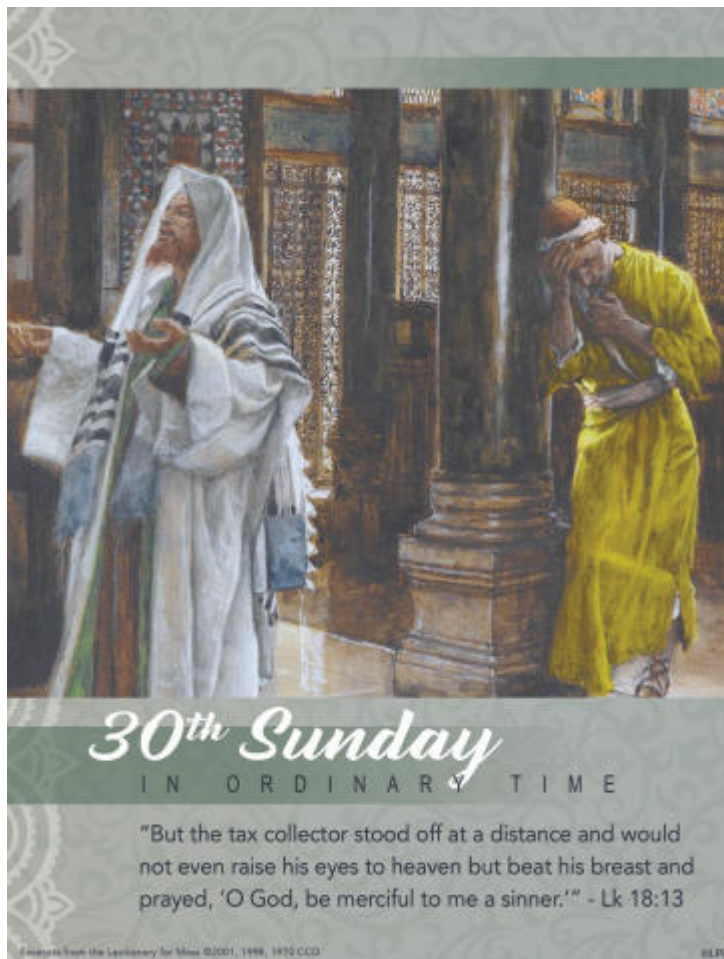

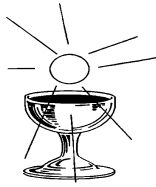

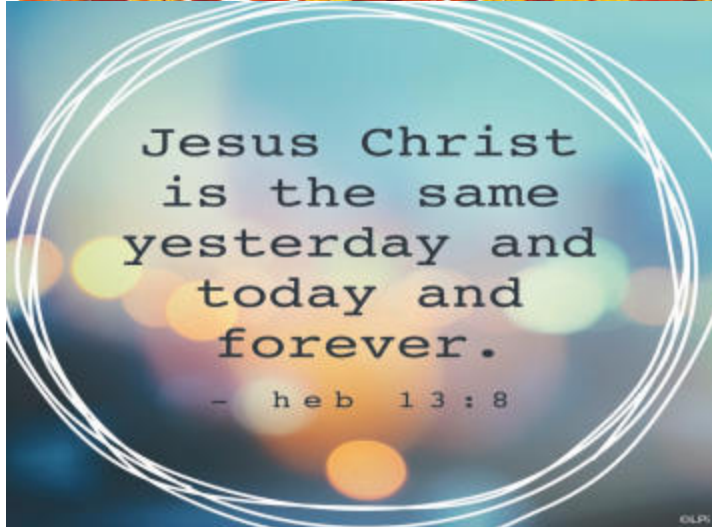

October Men's Night Out

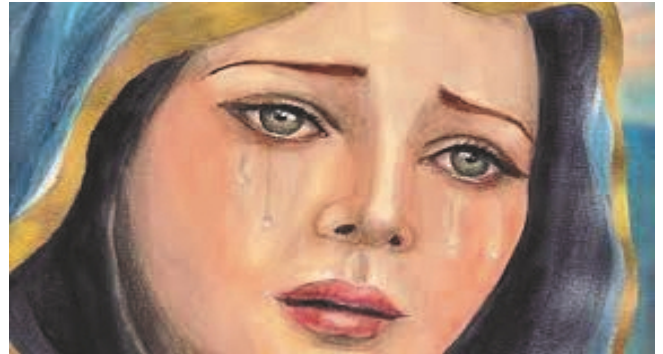

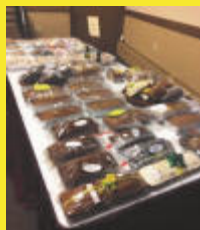

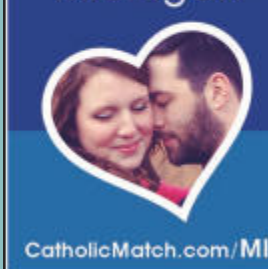
