Meals on Wheels

Do you want to make a difference in our local community and put your faith into action through service? St. Tim's parishioners provide drivers to deliver hot meals to the homebound. St Tim's has two teams of drivers: one team serves Blaine and Coon Rapids and the other serves Fridley, Columbia Heights, Hill Top, and Spring Lake Park. Teams drive every eight weeks. Drivers can choose to drive as many days of the assigned week that fit their schedule, whether one, two or even all five days. Routes have 8-10 stops and take 1-1.5 hours to complete. Training is provided for new volunteers. This is a great opportunity for retirees, or for working adults that can take an extended lunch break. To join, contact the parish office and indicate if you're interested in joining the Blaine and Coon Rapids team or the Fridley, Columbia Heights, Hill Top, and Spring Lake Park team. Join in providing meals and connection to people in their homes!
