St. Catherine's University Discipleship Practices Program

Since August 2021, St. Timothy has been participating in the Discipleship Practices Program hosted by St. Catherine's University and funded through a Lilly Thriving

St. Catherine university

Congregations grant. St. Tim's is participating along with several other congregations in the Twin Cities metro area. The program has provided funding for our parish to purchase our new sacred art collection, has hosted several daylong retreats, an offered formation to parishioners.

The program's purpose is to support congregations reaching out in discipleship to a hurting world in need of compassion, healing, and justice. Discipleship represents an engaged Christian life actively involved in efforts to humanize the world, representing the ways that (in the words of Pope Francis) the "Church constantly goes out from herself...in commitment to the poor" (*Evangelii Gaudium*, 2013).

During each two-year practice period of the program, two or three parishioners take graduate courses at St. Catherine's: *Church and Sacraments, Spirituality for*

Discipleship, and God and Christ. During the first practice period (2021-2023), Avis Braschayko and Anita Cholewa completed the courses at St. Catherine's.

Avis created a quilted piece of art entitled *Trinity* that draws inspiration from mosaics and the art of the St. John's Illuminated Bible. The quilted piece synthesizes her insights and reflections from course readings and discussions.

Anita put her learning into practice through developing content for bulletin inserts and the website to educate and inspire parishioners to put faith into practice through caring for Earth, our common home. She also coordinated a visit by Shawn Phillips to St. Tim's to speak about

indigenous understanding of creation and spirituality in September 2022. Anita reflected, "I have always been in awe of the intricacies and connectedness of God's creation." This led her to choose care for creation as her St. Kate's practicum practice.

The second practice period will begin soon and three St. Timothy parishioners will take courses: Chris Patterson, Christine Patterson, Liz Gallagher. St. Timothy staff member Rhonda Miska will assist in serving as an instructor. Please pray for them as the new practice period of the program begins. 
