Donate to the Country Store



Church of St. Timothy Summer 2025 Mission Appeal

Father Jose Putenparambil, from the Catholic diocese of Vijayapuram in Kerala, India, will speak at all Masses on the weekend of August 9-10. Father Jose will share about the ministry in Vijayapuram, particularly among those who have been part of the Dalit caste (sometimes called "untouchables" who have faced historic marginalization.







The diocese of Vijayapuram has an area of 3,475 square miles and is headquartered in the town of Kottayam. Its institutions include 84 parishes, 125 mission stations, 76 schools, five retreat centers, one college for nurses, five training centres, two hospitals, nine clinics and two nursing homes. Christians only make up about 2.4% of the total population in India.

This mission appeal is specifically seeking support for the construction of the Immaculate Heart home for people with disabilities, especially those with autism and Down Syndrome. Construction of the Immaculate Heart Home has begun and more financial support is needed to complete and make it operational to serve families.
