Segunda Lectura: 1 Corintios 15:45-49

Pablo retrata a Adán como el primer hombre físico ya Jesús como el primer hombre que nos da nuestra espiritualidad. Un hombre fue formado del polvo, el otro descendido del cielo. Así como nos parecemos físicamente al primer ser, debemos modelarnos a nosotros mismos como Jesús espiritualmente.

Ewangelia: Łukasza 6:27-38

Jezus wyjaśnia, że kochanie tylko tych, którzy nas kochają, nie jest wielkim osiągnięciem. LENTEN REFLECTIONS

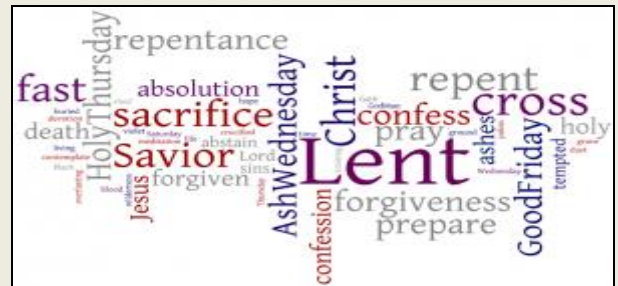
