

## CRS RICE BOWL REPORT

Our parish collected nearly \$650.00 to help our sisters and brothers across the globe, and here locally. For the past three years, our parish Soup Kitchen has received a \$1,000 grant from CRS. Your Rice Bowl contributions make that possible! Thank you very much!

## **The 2020 Wabash Valley Rubber Duck Regatta was a huge success and we need to thank YOU!**

This year **15,000** rubber ducks (a new record!) were adopted and released into the Wabash River on July 4<sup>th</sup>. The impact of COVID-19 on our community has resulted in both health and economic hardships for many. The amazing support we received will allow us to continue to serve many of these impacted families, many who find themselves in need for the first time.

The 2020 Regatta raised **more than \$50,000** with each dollar going directly to ending hunger and providing housing and hope to the needy of west central Indiana.

As in the past, St. Bens' Parishioners responded to THCC call for help by responding generously with their duck adoptions. This years winner is a member of our parish family! The winner of the 2020 Wabash Valley Rubber Duck Regatta was ICE Rigging, a local business here in Terre Haute owned by Andy Curry. 
## **Offer to MATCH your gift to St. Bens RESULTS:**
