

The War in Ukraine and Refugee Needs

The war in Ukraine has moved into its third month and news of the horrifying details of Russian bombardment of the country have all but disappeared from the headlines. It seems that other events and other tragedies have taken their place. It is important for us to remember that the horror and the devastation on the ground in Ukraine continues. This week the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights announced that 6.8 million Ukrainian citizens have become refugees, most fleeing to neighboring Poland, Hungry and Bulgaria. The number of refugees is well more than the total populations of the states of Iowa, Nebraska and South Dakota combined. Since males who can stay to defend their country are not permitted to leave Ukraine, the vast majority of the refugees are women and children. A full-scale humanitarian crisis is unfolding before our eyes. We would like to undertake a local effort to help feed some of these Ukrainian refugees. We have begun an initiative to partner with an lowa organization that assists refugees throughout the world. They have begun a major effort to provide meals to as many of the Ukrainian Refugees as possible. Our parishes' youth ministry programs would like to sponsor a food assembly event here in Dickinson County that would prepare 40,000 meals to send to Polish food distribution centers that are assisting the refugee crisis there. In comparison to the huge crying need this is only a small effort but it can make a great impact on a portion of those suffering the loss of home and security. Our goal is twofold: 1) To raise awareness among the young people of Dickinson County of the need to be attentive to suffering in the world and in particular to needs of young people who have been forced from their homes and away from their families. 2) We want to feed as many people as we can. The cost for this one-day assembly event is \$15,000,00 for the food plus expenses incurred with setting up the event, renting an assemble space, and shipping the food to Europe. We have begun fund raising here in our communities and you will be hearing more about our funding efforts and event planning in the weeks to come. Please watch the bulletin for more regular updates on this project. For information on our partner in this effort please check out: outreachprogram. org. Together we can make a difference.
