


We are continuing to plan for our outreach to Ukrainian citizens who have been forced from their homes due to the incursion into sovereign Ukrainian territory by Russian armed forces. More than 8 million citizens have been displaced within Ukrainian territory and 7 million (mostly women and children) have fled their homeland for safety in neighboring countries. Our fund-raising efforts continue to be successful and as of this printing we are planning on preparing 120,000 meals at our mega packaging event on August 10th. This great effort will take place at the Event Center on the Dickinson County Fairgrounds. We need volunteers for each of the three scheduled work periods scheduled from 9 to 10 a.m., 2 to 4 p.m. and from 6 to 8 p.m. If you are able to volunteer for this important event, we invite you to register at our dedicated "Sign-up Genius". Below you will find a black and white Quick Response ("QR") code that is meant to quickly take a user to a website without fumbling with the entry of a web address. Here is how to use:

- Open the camera application on your phone or tablet
- Position the camera so that the QR code is in the frame of the camera's view. Your camera should scan that code without any action required by you.
- A notification should pop up asking if you would like to go to the site that is linked to the code.
 - Tap the notification and you are on your way to the site!

We need 120 volunteers for each of the the scheduled time slots. Reminder: Volunteers who are under the age of 18 are asked to provide their parent's contact information. Groups of volunteers can provide a single chaperone's contact information.

Please pray for the success of this program and pray fervently for peace in Ukraine and for countless refugees.
