





#### **Special Days of Prayer for Vocations**

Starting this September, Bishop Nickless has inaugurated a Year of Vocations, asking both the clergy and the faithful of the diocese to participate in special days of prayer for an increase in religious vocations and an increase in holiness among all vocations in the Church. These special days of prayer are called Ember Days

Ember Days are traditional days of prayer and fasting that mark the changing of times and seasons in order to give thanks to God and to bring a deeper spiritual renewal. On these days, the Church 'entreats the Lord for the various needs of humanity" and gives thanks to God for various blessings received (Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, 45). These traditional days of fasting punctuate the year with special prayers and personal sacrifices.

The word "Ember" is not tied to ashes or coals. Instead, it is derived from the Latin phrase Quator Tempora meaning "four times." Based on the changing of the seasons the Church established four periods to sanctify the passing of time, in which days of prayer and fasting may bring about greater spiritual fruit.

The Ember Days for the coming year have been scheduled for: September 16, 2022, December 16, 2022, March 24, 2023 and June 16, 2023.

The special Vocation intentions for Ember Day, Friday, September 16th are as follows:

Pray the Rosary for the holiness of the deacons, priests, and bishops, and for an increase in vocations of those called to Holy Orders. Fast by eating only one main meal and two smaller meals, or fast from social media.
