



#### **Cemetery Decorations**

As we look forward to Memorial Day, we are conscious that we want our cemeteries to look their best. We have a number of families who have left plastic flowers, decorations and other memorabilia on graves throughout the cemetery. We ask all families to please remove all decorations that have been left there throughout the winter and remember that we have a long-standing policy that all Memorial Day decorations MUST be removed for cemetery plots but June 12th, two weeks after Memorial Day. It is very difficult for our maintenance crew to work around decorations that are left on the ground around family graves. Elevated pot holders are permitted if they are anchored directly beside a grave marker or stone. We are aware that there were several "winter problems" at the cemetery. Badgers and gophers have been at work again and we lost a sign during the winter. We are replacing the signage and are hard at work to address the rodent problem with traps so please be careful to watch your step and keep your pets on a leash when walking in the cemetery. Please recall that our cemetery is closed between dusk and dawn each day.
