





Last weekend's lead up to the 4th of July holiday brought huge crowds to the area and large crowds to Masses at both St. Joseph St. Mary's. We had seven Masses over the course of the weekend with one in each parish on Saturday evening and three on Sunday morning at St. Joseph's and two at St. Mary's. We had a total of more than 3,100 faithful Catholics attend Mass in our parishes. This is a beautiful thing. Both of our church buildings and parking lots were stretched beyond capacity. While standing room only crowds do not make for optimal prayer experiences we are overjoyed and deeply grateful for the many families on vacation who flooded in for the celebration of the Holy Mass. We know that such huge crowds sometimes test the gracious hospitality that our parishes are known for. We want to express gratitude to our own parishioners who showed up a bit early to get a seat and sat in their cars as the parking lots slowly emptied out. On these crowded weekends, our limited off-street parking is a problem. Next year, with the redesign of our neighborhood streets at St. Joseph's we know that we will be losing a number of street parking stalls. We are in the process of formulating a plan to make parking egress less of a bottleneck at St. Joseph. At both parishes, we are grateful for our many neighbors who are patient with us on Sunday mornings as nearby streets are somewhat narrowed with parked cars. Faithfulness to weekly Mass brings blessings to families which often cannot be measured for many years. Our holiday crowds bring grace to our whole Catholic Community here in the Lakes Area.
