Steven Brodersen, 75, of Carroll, who died Thurs., July 20 at his home near Carroll following a courageous battle with cancer. His Mass of Christian Burial was Thurs., July 27 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church-St. John Paul II Parish, in Carroll.

Fr. Steven Brodersen was born on September 7, 1947 in Laurens, Iowa to William L. and Marcella (Yender) Brodersen. He grew up near Rush Lake, and graduated from Ayrshire High School in 1965. Following high school Steve went on to attend Peru State College in Peru, Nebraska. In 1970, Steve was inducted into the United States Army where he served overseas in Germany. Following his honorable discharge in 1973 he began teaching at St. Edmund High School in Ft. Dodge.

After a few years teaching, Steve enrolled at St. Paul's Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota. On December 28, 1985, Steve was ordained a Roman Catholic Priest at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Milford. 



Sacramental Sponsors and the Practice of the Catholic Faith

From time to time, it is good for us to review the policies and directives of the Church regarding reception of the Sacraments. Today I want to address the issue of sponsors for Baptism. The Baptism of a child is a moment of great rejoicing for a family and for the whole Church. Baptism is one of the greatest joys and privileges of my priesthood. I rejoice in every single family that brings a child forward for Baptism. There are several important points that families should take into consideration as they look forward to a Baptismal ceremony. Parents should be conscious that as the baptismal ceremony unfolds, they are asked to commit themselves to raising their child in the ways of the faith. This is a reiteration of the promises that they made at their sacramental marriage. Parents are charged to take this responsibility seriously. Their promises before God to take the faith life of their children to heart is a deep vow that should not be undertaken lightly. Parents are the first teachers of their children in the ways of the faith and are called to enter into this task with devotion and purpose. Church law carefully regulates the sponsors of Baptism as well. When a child is presented for Baptism, they are to have at least one sponsor who vows to assist the parents of the child in the practice of the faith. Again, the ceremony contains a commitment by the sponsor to take seriously their commitment to assist the parents of the child in the ways of the faith. The child can also have two sponsors, one of each gender. The Code of Canon Law indicates, "There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each." (873) Canon law is careful to outline what is necessary for a person to qualify and a sponsor for Baptism. They are as follows: 1) The sponsor must be willing to take up the role of sponsor 2) The sponsor must be at least 16 years of age 3) They must be baptized, confirmed, and have

received 1st Holy Communion 4) They must be leading a life of faith by attending Mass, and cannot be in an irregular marriage. 5) They cannot be one of the parents of the child. A member of a non-Catholic community can act as a Christian witness in the place of one of the Godparents. When a couple is choosing a sponsor for their child's Baptism, it is important to keep these guidelines outlined in Church law in mind.
