Greetings! Okoboji schools are in session this week! Where did the summer go? Please join me in praying for the teachers, associates, and administration as they prepare for the 2023-2024 school year at our area schools. Also, be praying for our students and their families as they start up again this week!

If you haven't already, please register your child(ren) in grades K-12. It isn't too late! The cost is \$45 per child without exceeding \$135 per family. Beginning this year, your child will be given a workbook, prayer book, and all the supplies they will need in the classroom. If you are in need of financial assistance, please do not hesitate to reach out. We will not exclude anyone.

Please note that the times have changed for our Wednesday classes. Grades K-4 will meet from 5-6:15pm and Grades 5-12 will meet from 6:45-8pm. This is a big change for our younger grades, but it allows for more people to commit to being catechists and volunteers. Our classes will begin on Wednesday, September 6!

Did you know that median age for disaffiliation from Catholicism is 13? 13!!! The reasons are various. Catholic young people have questions, doubts, and concerns about the Catholic faith, the Church, and how to integrate the faith with the rest of their lives. 



Lake and Calvary in Milford are wonderful, quiet places to go and pray an remember our beloved dead. Over the summer months we have been finding bottles and cans at some of the graves in our cemeteries. While we welcome and encourage parish members to visit the graves of their loved ones any time during the day, it is highly offensive for people to engage in the consumption of alcohol at our cemeteries.
