

Greetings! Happy Advent! The second candle on the Advent Wreath is lit, and we are called to reflect on PEACE. Jesus offers us peace, but we have to be willing to get rid of the things that get in the way of it. Every week, Fr. Hughes offers the opportunity to receive the peace of Christ through the sacrament of Reconciliation. Our sins get in the way of peace. Repentance brings peace. Today at 4 p.m., Communal Penance will be offered. I kindly invite you and encourage you to attend. Maybe it's been months, a year, or decades since your last confession. I am here to tell you that it's never too late. You're never too far gone. Jesus wants to grant you His peace. We need the peace of Christ to experience the glory of Christmas.
