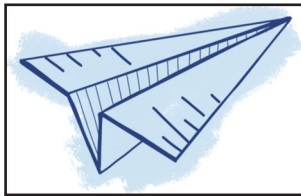
Appliance Collection

Beware of Scams

Recently several parish members have received messages that propose to be from Father Hughes asking for money or gift cards. The first text message includes a greeting and a request for a return message. After the return message there is a request for money or gift cards for assistance in a tragic situation. A message follows instructing the parish member to buy gift cards and then open the seal on the gift card and take a photograph and send it. These kinds of messages are a complete and total scam. Fr. Hughes will never elicit funds over the phone, via text message or via an email. Please disregard these requests for payment and delete them as soon as they arrive. Please be careful to examine the phone number and email address of these requests. The messages often make the request sound urgent. PLEASE disregard any requests that falsely identify Fr Hughes as requesting financial assistance in any way.
