Summer With Jesus, Mary, and Joseph!

The Sisters of Merciful Jesus and a dozen wonderful volunteers led a 5-day Summer Camp at the Sacred Heart campus a few weeks ago, hosting over 40 children in a Holy Land travel experience. Each morning, with their Christian passports in hand and backpacks on their backs, the children crossed the borders to Nazareth, Bethlehem or Egypt to experience life with the Holy Family. We used the five mysteries in St. Joseph's rosary, one mystery for each day, which are: 1) Betrothal to Mary (Mt 1:18); 2) Annunciation to Joseph (Mt 1:19-21); 3) Birth and Naming of Jesus (Mt 1:22-25); 4) Flight into Egypt (Mt 2:13-15; and 5) Hidden Life at Nazareth (Mt 2:23; Lk 2:51-52).

Morning catechesis always included a song and prayer, then after a quick snack there was a craft related to the theme of the day. The highlight was Noon Mass upstairs in the church, where the children got to sing the new songs they learned, and those who couldn't receive Holy Communion received a blessing from the priest. Lunch was followed by games either outdoors or in the gym. The day concluded at 3:00pm after a sung decade of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Thank you to Fr. Mele and all the generous benefactors and volunteers who made the camp possible!

- Child Abuse History
- Criminal Record Check
- FBI Fingerprint (or waiver)



St. Ignatius of Loyola wrote the Spiritual Exercises to assist people in deepening their faith and finding God in all things. Ignatius also wrote instructions that showed how the Spiritual Exercises could be used in everyday life.

Following the 19th Annotation version of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius, the Bridges Program is a “retreat in the midst of daily life” that helps busy people build a bridge to:

Prayer Develop your relationship with Jesus while creating a lifelong habit of personal prayer.

Spirituality Grow in gospel values by learning how to put on the mind and heart of Jesus.

Discover your place in the communion of saints and be guided by a prayer companion.

Learn the practice of spiritual discernment that reveals your personal calling.

This 9-month program asks for a steady commitment of time and energy: daily personal prayer in accordance with the Spiritual Exercises (a total of an hour a day is encouraged.); and weekly contact with your Prayer Companion, face to-face, by phone or email. (Day, time and place is mutually agreed upon by you and your partner.) On alternate Sundays there will be instructional and faith-sharing sessions with your fellow retreatants (1:30 – 2:30 p.m.), and an individual meeting with your Prayer Companion (2:30 – 3:30 p.m.) at Sacred Heart Church, 310 Shady Ave., Pittsburgh, PA.
