

Mission Statement

We are an urban parish of Pittsburgh's East End dedicated to serving one another both within and outside our parish, but especially to the poor and marginalized of our community. **“I do believe!
Help my unbelief.”**



RAISE YOUR HAND if your faith is perfect. That’s what I thought. It’s not because I doubt you or your good nature or even your intent to live a faith filled life – it’s just that *we are human and faith is hard*. We might actually sometimes think that a true faith-filled life seems impractical or impossible. In Mark’s Gospel, a man had a son who had a mute spirit. Not only could he not speak, but the demon would throw him into convulsions and cause him to injure himself. The father was desperate and asked Jesus “If you can do anything, have pity on us and help us.” The father was suffering just as much as the child. Jesus responds incredulously: “If you can!” and then He encourages the father: “All things are possible to him who believes.” The father readily admits that his faith is not perfect and cries out: “help my unbelief.”

IT DOESN’T MATTER WHY your faith is imperfect. There are many reasons: bad examples from others, poor teaching about the faith, trauma that pulled us away, all of the above or none of the above. Sometimes its just a matter of timing – many of us went through ‘catechesis’ in a time in our lives when other things were much more important. When we don’t understand who Jesus is and how that relates to our Church and what it teaches, our faith suffers. We still believe, but we may need a little help for our faith life to be real and tangible.

This is why **RCIA IS FOR EVERYONE**. It is the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Adults who are choosing it, not being told to go, or obliged to attend. For some, who are actually being initiated into the Catholic Faith for the first time, this is a somewhat formal process of evangelizing and educating (catechizing sounds like a medical procedure). For the rest of us, it is an opportunity to legitimately examine what we believe and wrestle with it, as necessary, so that our belief may become ‘helped’.

This year we have at least five people, and perhaps many more (I might be talking to you, spouse of a Catholic that comes to Mass every week) who will officially go through the RCIA process. We would like for you to consider journeying with them. For your own benefit, to build your own faith, and for their benefit. Jesus has commissioned ALL OF US to make disciples of all nations. **THIS IS NOT OPTIONAL FOR CHRISTIANS**. You might not be able to teach about the faith, but you can walk along side, welcome, invite, provide hospitality and friendship – these are all parts of making disciples and the teacher cannot fill all of these roles.

So this year we will be taking a new approach to RCIA – we will advertise our weekly topics and gatherings so that **ANYONE CAN JOIN IN**. Maybe a particular topic has always been a bit mysterious to you, or raises serious questions – well come that week then. Maybe you just are good at befriending others and making them feel welcome – come when you can.

Symbolon/ RCIA Schedule

Symbolon is an engaging video series from Augustine Institute that teaches all aspects of the Catholic Faith. The sessions are open to ALL PARISHIONERS, but will be used as the basis for our RCIA program. Each night will have a brief 'Liturgy of the Word' followed by the Symbolon video (< 30 minutes) and group discussion.

The Spiritual Exercises are designed to lead us to more fully accept and respond to God's personal unconditional love for each of us. We are led to uncover any obstacles that keep our relationship with God from flourishing. St. Ignatius wrote the Spiritual Exercises to assist people in deepening their faith and finding God in all things.

The Spiritual Exercises will be offered at Sacred Heart Church this year by trained Prayer Companions and will run from September 2022 through May 2023. Here's what past participants have shared about their experience:

"Bridges helped me understand that I have a personal relationship with Christ to nourish and develop. The daily commitment with liturgy and prayer along with the guidance of a spiritual director on a weekly basis helped me in my spiritual growth. The support of having a group to share with and listen to, made the experience even more enriching in a most humbling way."

"I reluctantly enrolled in the Bridges Program through the loving persuasion of my wife. After the first few meetings, I began to feel comfortable around the participants because there was encouragement but no pressure from anyone to continue with the program or to participate at the meetings. Upon being assigned to a Prayer Director who would meet with me on a one-on-one basis, I gradually began to feel closer to God. The change was and still is so gradual that it has amazingly become a natural part of my personal relationship with God."

Prayers and Best Wishes to Father Jay Donahue

Father Jay Donahue, one of the 'native sons' from our parish was granted a six-month sabbatical. The diocese offers this for priests who have been ordained for 12 years or more. Walking With Moms In Need

In speaking to the United Nations in 2020, Pope Francis stated “it is troubling to see how simple and convenient it has become for some to deny the existence of a human life as a solution to problems that can and must be solved for both the mother and her unborn child” “Accompaniment” means to journey together with a person who is faced with difficult circumstances. 
