The Easter Procession with the Ambrose-Romanos Singers

On Sunday, April 16 at 4:00pm, the Ambrose-Romanos Singers, a professional liturgical choir of men and women based here in Pittsburgh, will lead "The Easter Procession: Eight Encounters with the Risen Christ" at Sacred Heart Church.

Easter is a fifty-day celebration of the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ from the dead, and is the most important celebration of the Church's Year of Grace. The Easter Procession is a chance to see and hear eight of Jesus' appearances to His disciples. Based on liturgical texts and chant from the Eastern Church (based in Ukraine), and featuring eight beautiful icons, we will use song and movement and visual art to enter even more deeply into the mystery of the Resurrection.

Everyone is invited to take part in this beautiful celebration. Come and learn to breathe with your "eastern lung," as Pope St. John Paul II described it.

This is a liturgical service, completely sung. There is no charge. Please come and bring your family and friends. The service is about 50 minutes long.

A Deep Dive into the Divine: Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in Our Parish

Jesus is Risen He is truly Risen! Alleluia!

May this flame be found still burning by the Morning Star: the one Morning Star who never sets, Christ your Son, who, coming back from death's domain, has shed his peaceful light on humanity, and lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

The Liturgy of the Light in the Atrium!

"Resurrection is such a great mystery that a celebration is required if we are to really begin to grasp its meaning! The Church enters the season of Easter with the Liturgy of Light at the Easter Vigil. In the atrium we do this same celebration, though slightly modified so that the children can participate more fully and at a pace that is particularly suited to them. In our religious experience with children in the atrium, we have seen how the quality of celebration should permeate all of catechesis. The Liturgy of the Light is a particularly intense moment of celebration.

What is proclaimed in the Bible is lived in the liturgy. Helping the children to experience this reality (as we found with the Good Shepherd parable and the Mass) offers them an opportunity to enjoy more fully the relationship they have with God and others.

This is especially true in the Liturgy of the Light. It is one of their atrium experiences that remains most vivid in the children's memories, even when they become adults." (From the book Joyful Journey)

Novena in Preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy

Join the Sisters of Merciful Jesus in the Divine Mercy Novena this year!

Merciful Jesus has tremendous graces in store for us on Divine Mercy Sunday, and He invites us to prepare our hearts to receive them not only by making a sacramental confession beforehand, but by praying a novena which He Himself revealed to St. Faustina in 1937. The novena begins on Good Friday, and will be prayed in St. Jude Parish again this year according to the schedule below. Jesus told St. Faustina:



"I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fount of My mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever graces they need in the hardships of life and, especially, at the hour of death. On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the house of My Father. (...) On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My bitter Passion, for graces for these souls." (Diary 1209)

The groups of souls we pray for during each of the nine days were specified by Jesus Himself. We can often see ourselves and our loved ones as included. Merciful Jesus assures us, "I will deny nothing to any soul whom you will bring to the fount of My mercy" (Diary 1209). So let us boldly come to Him with all of the intentions closest to our hearts and beg Him, by virtue of His bitter Passion, to have mercy on us and on the whole world!

The Feast of Divine Mercy — Divine Mercy Sunday

We are so excited to celebrate the Divine Mercy Sunday, a wonderful feast in the Church calendar that falls one week after Easter. This year on Sunday, April 16, the Sisters of Merciful Jesus will celebrate with the Hour of Mercy at 3:00pm at St. Raphael Church. There will be exposition, confessions, chaplet to Divine Mercy, reflections from St. Faustina's Diary, and live music. Please join us on this day when Our Merciful Savior offers us unequalled graces, and He wants each one of us to draw close to the Fountain of Divine Mercy and allow Him to act in our souls. We invite you to prepare for the Feast by reading about it below and fulfilling the requirements Jesus gave to us. Get ready for a new life of grace!

"(W)hoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment" (*Diary* 300).

"On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet" (*Diary* 699).

Every single Catholic who has made their First Confession and received their First Holy Communion has access on that day to the floods of grace pouring out from the pierced Heart of the Savior. What do I need to do?

- Go to Confession on or within 8 days before the actual Feast. Sacramental Confession is a must.
- 2. Attend Holy Mass on the Feast and receive Holy Communion. Jesus is ready to elevate the grace of your Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday to that of a second Baptism!
- 3. Pray for the Holy Father's intentions, desiring to receive an indulgence. The Church offers us a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday, so we pray the customary Our Father and Creed for intentions of the Holy Father. Yet we know we are receiving even more than an indulgence: a fresh start and a clean slate—a new chance to become a saint!
- 4. Show mercy to others. Jesus told St. Faustina, "Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy Even the strongest faith is of no avail without works" (Diary 742). So, when we leave the church, we need to go out and "Be merciful as the Father is merciful."




