

The Feast of Divine Mercy — Divine Mercy Sunday

We are so excited to celebrate the Divine Mercy Sunday, a wonderful feast in the Church calendar that falls one week after Easter. Today on Sunday, April 16, the Sisters of Merciful Jesus will celebrate with the Hour of Mercy at 3:00pm at St. Raphael Church. There will be exposition, confessions, chaplet to Divine Mercy, reflections from St. Faustina's Diary, and live music. Please join us on this day when Our Merciful Savior offers us unequalled graces, and He wants each one of us to draw close to the Fountain of Divine Mercy and allow Him to act in our souls. We invite you to prepare for the Feast by reading about it below and fulfilling the requirements Jesus gave to us. Get ready for a new life of grace!

"(W)hoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment" (*Diary* 300).

"On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet" (*Diary* 699).

Every single Catholic who has made their First Confession and received their First Holy Communion has access on that day to the floods of grace pouring out from the pierced Heart of the Savior. What do I need to do?

- 1. Go to Confession on or within 8 days before the actual Feast. Sacramental Confession is a must.
- 2. Attend Holy Mass on the Feast and receive Holy Communion. Jesus is ready to elevate the grace of your Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday to that of a second Baptism!
- 3. Pray for the Holy Father's intentions, desiring to receive an indulgence. The Church offers us a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday, so we pray the customary Our Father and Creed for intentions of the Holy Father. Yet we know we are receiving even more than an indulgence: a fresh start and a clean slate—a new chance to become a saint!
- 4. Show mercy to others. Jesus told St. Faustina, "Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy Even the strongest faith is of no avail without works" (Diary 742). So, when we leave the church, we need to go out and "Be merciful as the Father is merciful."

St. Jude Parish was blessed this past Saturday evening, at the Easter Vigil, to welcome five new members of the Body of Jesus Christ here at our Parish: Alexandra Gialenze, Cairo Palmieri, and Clara Olsen were baptized, and Samuel Figuera and Robert Marshall were received, as already baptized Christians, into the fullness of the Catholic Church.

All five received the Sacrament of Confirmation, and their First Holy Communion. Their faith was an inspiring witness to all of us, at our beautiful Easter Vigil Mass. Those of us who shared their RCIA journey with them these past many months, have come to know and love each one of them. We hope that many of our Parishioners will come to know and love them as well. We thank the Lord Jesus for the gift they are to us, and we congratulate and thank all five of them - for the witness of their faithfulness to the Lord's call in their lives.


Retreat for Moms
