

## A Deep Dive into the Divine: Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in Our Parish

This Fourth Sunday of the Easter Season is lovingly referred to as "Good Shepherd Sunday".

When we are in the Atrium with the children, we announce the parable, meditate with the children and wonder with them about the words of Jesus. We allow the child to work with the materials as part of their own meditation, as well as time for silence, prayer or song. The most difficult thing for us to do as adults is to simply stop and be still. We do not want to put ourselves between the Word of God and the child. In parables, we let the scripture do the teaching. We do not tell the children how to interpret parables or offer definitions of the parable, as no one formula or definition speaks to everyone at the same time.



Lauren Kowalski (one of the mothers from our CGS program) shares a few words about what her son has been experiencing in the Atrium:

Alexander looks forward to visiting the atrium every week. Since starting CGS, we have noticed that Alexander enjoys talking about Jesus and learning about different saints. He is especially interested in The Blessed Mother. I greatly appreciate how CGS helps Alexander to learn about God and the Church in a way that is accessible to him. This has enabled him to have more interest in weekly mass and he frequently asks me to read from the Gospel at bedtime, or children's books about our religion. CGS is truly a valued part of Alexander's education and we are so pleased to have this opportunity. It has been such a blessing for my son's spiritual development and relationship with God. I am so very grateful for the services of Sister Emily, Celine Mitchell, Miss Lucy, and all the catechists who are contributing so much to the children of our parish and the future of the Church.
