## Corpus Christi Procession

On the **Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Sunday, June 11**, we will begin the Parish Year of the Eucharistic Revival.



Beginning at 4:00pm at Saint Raphael Church, St. Jude Parish will host the singing of Solemn Evening Prayer for Corpus Christi. Following the service, please join us for a Eucharistic Procession through Morningside followed by Benediction. What an amazing witness to the Faith!

The singing for the service will be led by the professional liturgical choir, the Ambrose-Romanos Singers. The service, which will be completely sung, will feature choral music by Renaissance composers, with Gregorian chant sung in English, and a newly-composed Magnificat for choir and harp. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament during the service.

Ask your family and friends to join us as we give thanks to God for the wondrous mystery of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

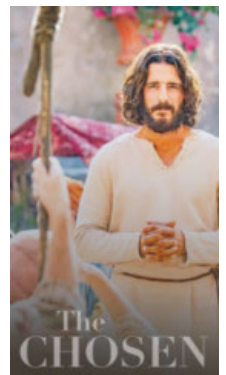

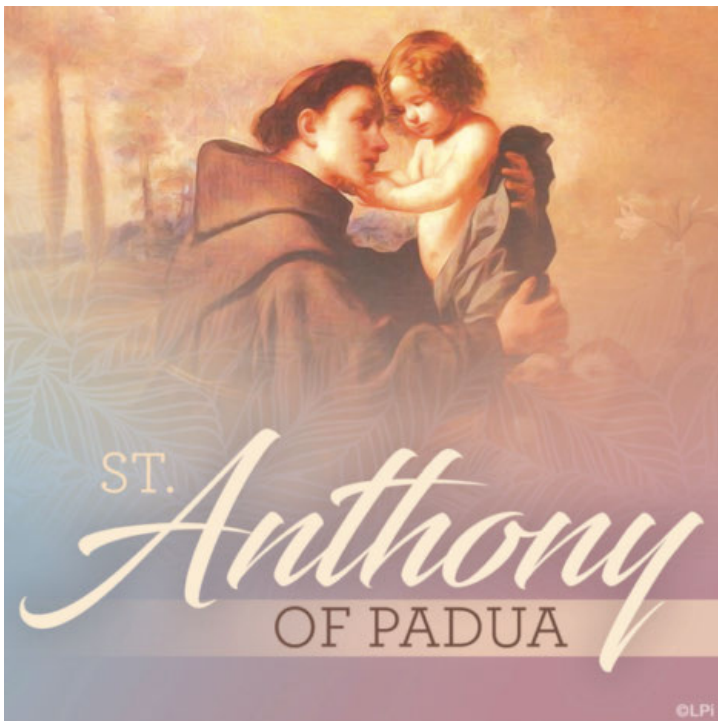

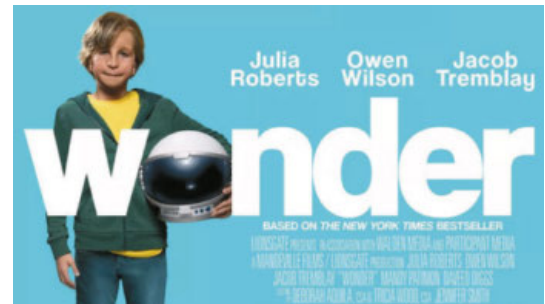


## Save the Date: Parish Movie Night!

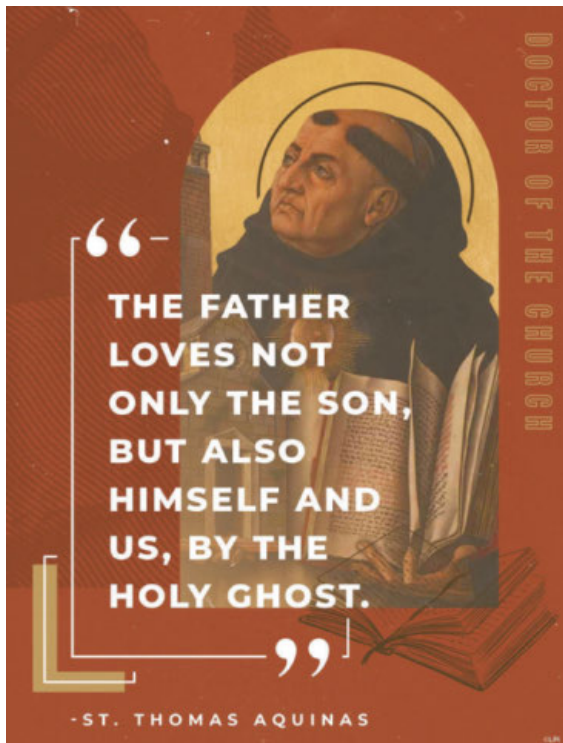

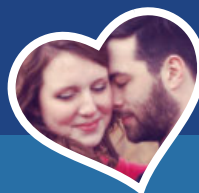
