Nick Davidson - Vagabond Missionary

Hello! My name is Nick Davidson, and I've worked as an inner city missionary for two years.

The organization that I work for is a Catholic mission group called Vagabond Missions. Since 2021 I have been working in the Pittsburgh neighborhood of Garfield, where I have encountered some of the funniest, lively, and caring people that I have ever met. The teens are also some of the most loving people I



have ever met despite the hardships that they come from, which only bolsters the fact that these kids need love and attention more than anything else. We have after school programming multiple days weekly, but a lot of my job includes driving teens to school or work, taking teens to mass, or even just to pray at our church, getting food with them when there's no food at home, and just simply taking them for a drive when they are bored out of their mind and the last place they want to be is at home. We also have camp over each summer for about a week, and various retreats that we hold throughout the year. It's because of how much I care about these teens and how much I love the mission as a whole that I have decided to stay as a missionary for a third year.

As a vagabond missionary I am called to live life the way that the Disciples did within the early church, and that also includes how I get my income. In order to work as a missionary, I have to fundraise my salary through donations from people who have joined me in mission through joining my support team. My support team is made up not only with people helping me monetarily, but also people that keep me and the teens in their prayers, which is the greatest thing I could ask for. That being said, mission is still not possible without the monetary donations that my support team provides. Before I can start my third year, I need to raise a certain amount of funds. I cannot get back to work with my kids until that money is raised. Because of this I am humbly inviting you to join my support team, whether it's through monetary donations, prayer, or both, and help me get back to working with the teens! 
Alzheimer's/Dementia Support Group


