

ECS Building Update

As you are aware, the former Saint Raphael Senior High School building has been leased to the Environmental Charter School (ECS). As such, they have a right to expect that the space will be protected both in terms of access and in the condition of rooms.

Effective immediately, access to the building will be restricted to provide for the safety of their students.

The pastor and pastoral council recognize how this impacts the life of the parish, especially for the Morningside community. As a parish, we have taken steps to alleviate the impact including relocating most regularly scheduled meetings to the former Saint Raphael Elementary School building as well as reporting the use of language by the ECS students both around the church and in the neighboring playground to school leadership. For their part, ECS has promised to work with teachers, staff, and students to resolve this issue.

In addition, the rental income received from ECS provides our parish finance council with the ability to engage an architectural firm to explore the possibility of erecting a new parish center on site that would be adjacent to the Church and provide for gathering spaces, meeting rooms, and parish offices. We appreciate everyone's flexibility and patience as we look towards a new and brighter future for our parish community.

Pastoral Planning - Envisioning Team and Purpose

An essential step before beginning a pastoral plan is to establish a parish Envisioning Team consisting of five to seven members. This team will assist Father with analyzing the results of the Disciple Maker Index Survey and in the creation of a pastoral plan. A pastoral plan lays the path for how best the parish is going to achieve its mission and lead parishioners in furthering our call to Jesus and our ability to lead others to Jesus.

The Church teaches that the purpose of the parish is to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the Sacraments, and promote works of charity all directed towards the salvation of souls. The process of pastoral planning will allow us to bring this purpose to life as we strive to live out the mission entrusted to the Church by Christ: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all of creation". (Mark 16:15).

As a reminder, in order to give ample time for all parishes to prepare for the distribution of DMI results and to ensure that all parishes are receiving information in a consistent manner, a universal distribution date for DMI results has been established for the weekend of August 19/20, 2023. All parishes in the diocese will use a common template to publish their individual results.

The weekend of August 26/27, 2023 aggregate results for the entire diocese will be published in parish bulletins.

St. Raphael Grounds Clean-Up

Since my arrival as Pastor in September 2022, I have tried to listen to parishioners from both Sacred Heart and Saint Raphael. There's still a lot of hurt, frustration, anger, and, plug in what else you may be feeling, lingering these years after the parish merger and closure of Saint Raphael School and regionalization of Sacred Heart School. I am hopeful that together we can keep moving forward. It's not fair to ask anyone to "just get over it" but, at the same time, we don't want to be stuck. For the two church communities of Saint Jude Parish to thrive going forward, we need to keep coming together. Sometimes that means that long held expectations need to change.

The maintenance crew at the parish is very good, but our men have an incredible amount of work on their plates each day. This leads them to triage what work they can accomplish in reasonable timeframes. This is where I'm asking for help. The Saint Raphael campus in particular is in need of care in preparation for the festival. The weeds need to be pulled, and much else needs to be done. This is your parish. Many people remember how beautiful that campus looked just a few years ago. I'm asking you to help bring it back to that state of beauty so that our guests visiting the festival and those coming to church can take pride in their space.

Thank you for helping! Both Saint Raphael and Sacred Heart are important parts of Saint Jude Parish. Let's all do what we can to build upon what has been handed on to us.


World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly


Special blessing of grandparents and the elderly after all Masses this weekend.

This Sunday, July 23, is the 3rd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Pope Francis instituted the celebration in 2021, which is to be held the fourth Sunday of July, near the feast day of Saints Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents. The theme this year is "His mercy is from age to age (Lk 1:50)," inspired by the Magnificat. In his message, Pope Francis shares the example of young Mary visiting her elderly cousin Elizabeth. He writes, "God wants young people to bring joy to the hearts of the elderly, as Mary did to Elizabeth, and gain wisdom from their experiences. Yet, above all, the Lord wants us not to abandon the elderly or to push them to the margins of life, as tragically happens all too often in our time." I invite you to read the entire letter from the Vatican online—it is a beautiful testimony of the gifts the young and old bring to each other.

If you are a grandparent or an elderly person, we want you to know that it is a joy to have you in our parish. After Masses this weekend, there will be a special blessing of grandparents and the elderly.




