

Reducing the Mass Schedule -Letting Go of 6PM and 7:45PM Weekend Masses

Saint Jude Parish has seven weekend Masses between Saturday evening and Sunday. Some of these Masses have seen their attendance grow while others have consistently low attendance. Of all seven, the 6PM on Saturday and 7:45PM on Sunday have the fewest people. The pastoral council has studied the issue of changing the Mass schedule for over a year and a half. You may remember last summer's opportunities to weigh in on the conversation. The pastoral council has advised me and suggests that dropping the 6PM and 7:45PM Masses is a needed step towards best utilizing our resources, including the priests of the parish. Speaking of those priests, I've also talked to Fr. John Sweeney and Fr. Steve Palsa to gauge their opinion regarding these two liturgies. Both agree that the time has come to let them go. This recommendation was first made to me upon my arrival as pastor in September 2022. I wanted to wait and see things for myself before making this final decision. I am ready to make this decision.

The weekend of August 26 & 27 will be the final weekend with a 6PM Saturday and 7:45PM Sunday Mass. The weekend of September 2 & 3 will be the first weekend without these Masses.

As pastor I understand that change and loss, while sometimes necessary, is almost always sad, perhaps frustrating, and certainly inconvenient. It is my hope that getting to know me over the last many months you will trust that my decision was not made lightly, not made quickly, and not made without prayerful consideration of those people who will be impacted by this reduction of Masses. I really hope that by pruning back a bit on our schedule the clergy of the parish can focus more attention on the existing Masses. I hope too that the people now displaced will find a ready welcome at another Mass time within St. Jude Parish.

You may be wondering if this is the only schedule change or if more change is coming. At this time, Fr. John, Fr. Steve, and I can continue to offer the other parish Masses. One day those dynamics will change, and a new conversation will need to take place. Together we will cross that bridge when we come to it.

If you or a family member have requested a Mass intention for one of the two Masses after the final weekend, the parish office will reach out to you to reschedule. We will do all that we can to accommodate your adjusted request.

Pastoral Priorities - DMI Update

As many of you may know, Bishop Zubik is requiring that every parish in the diocese create a pastoral plan that will help us grow our mission and ministry over the next three to five years. All pastoral plans are due by February 14, 2024, but may be submitted as soon as this fall due to staggered pastoral planning schedules and the efforts and diligence of the Envisioning Team.



These pastoral priorities will move the vision forward for the next three to five years. The priorities are to be focused on accomplishing the vision for the future set by the Envisioning Team while taking into account the priorities that Bishop Zubik has identified for the diocese as the priority focus areas:

- Evangelization
- Missionary Discipleship
- Shifting the focus of the parishes from Maintenance to Mission






Second Collection


