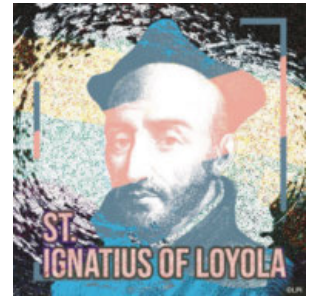

Disciple Maker Index Parish Results

I would like to thank all who participated in the Disciple Maker Index earlier this year. In total, 18% of weekly mass attendees at Saint Jude Parish completed the Survey.



The Disciple Maker Index provides our community with a deep analysis of attitudes and beliefs, participation, relationship/satisfaction, and demographics. At the same time, the DMI will assist us in assessing our greatest opportunities and strengths while developing a pastoral plan to move into the future by cultivating a deeper missionary spirit within the community.

Our Envisioning Team, composed of members of the parish, will study the data and use the results to help create a pastoral plan with specific goals and priorities for our parish community to focus on in the coming years. I am excited for where the Holy Spirit will lead Saint Jude Parish.

FOUR FACTORS OF A THRIVING PARISH

The DMI Survey collected responses on key areas of parish life that will allow us to continue to work toward becoming a more vibrant, thriving parish:

- **Leadership Indicators** - 80% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they would recommend our parish to others
- **Sunday Experience** - 75% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish makes them feel welcome and accepted
- **Spiritual Practices** - 98% of respondents state that they practice their Catholic faith
- **Missionary Impulse** - 80% of respondents state that they have prayed with someone on a frequent basis

STRENGTHS OF THE PARISH

The DMI Survey provided us information on what respondents saw as strengths of the parish:

- **Belief** - 92% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the Scripture is the Word of God
- **Community** - 75% of respondents strongly agree/agree that our parish provides a welcoming community
- **Preaching** - 68% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the preaching and homilies connect with everyday life
- **Information Availability** - 91% of respondents strongly agree/agree that information via the bulletin, website, and social media is easy to find

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH

The DMI Survey provided us areas of opportunity for growth:

- **Discipleship** - 54% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish is helping to form them as a disciple of Jesus Christ
- **Formation** - 39% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they feel confident that they can share the teachings of the Church with others
- **Music** - 42% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the music offered at Mass deepens their desire to participate more fully in the Liturgy

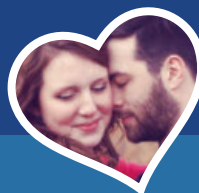
