

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Venerable Antonietta Meo (1930-1937), nicknamed *Nennolina* by her family, was a child born in Rome. Her family was deeply Catholic and sent her to a nursery school run by Catholic sisters. As a young child, she had a deep understanding of Christ's love.

When **Antonietta** was 6, her leg was amputated due to bone cancer. From this moment on, she experienced varying degrees of chronic pain. Shortly after, while she was still in the hospital, her father asked her if she was in pain.

Antonietta replied, "Daddy, the pain is like fabric, the stronger it is, the more value it has." All those who overheard were astounded. From then on, Antonietta frequently offered her pain and suffering to Jesus. Even at her young age, her understanding of prayer and suffering was inspiring to everyone. She was fitted with a prosthetic leg and is quoted as saying, "May each step that I take be a little word of love."

Impressed by her maturity and spiritual knowledge, her family priest recommended she receive her First Communion. She was ecstatic and received her First Communion on Christmas night of 1936. She was Confirmed a few months later. However the amputation had not stopped the spread of cancer and her health declined following these sacraments.

Throughout her life, **Antonietta** wrote hundreds of letters to Jesus and Mary. Pope Pius IX, who had heard of them from a friend, was impressed and sent an emissary to her house to ask her to pray for him. After her death, she was declared Venerable, and her writings reside at the Basilica of the Holy Cross of Jerusalem in Rome. *Venerable Antonietta Meo, pray for us!*
