Montana Tax Credit

St. Matthew's Catholic School SSO LLC is an approved Student Scholarship Organization (SSO) participating in the Tax Credit for Contributions to Student Scholarship Organizations Program. The program provides 100% tax credit to taxpayers or corporations filing Montana income tax returns (e.g. individuals corporations, nonprofits and other exempt organizations) that donate to certified SSOs. Eligible taxpayers can qualify for a tax credit of up to \$200,000 in the same calendar year their donation is made. Unused credits can be earned forward into future tax years. To receive a credit, interested parties should verify eligibility with a certified tax accountant or the Montana Department of Revenue.
