- Glacier Park pass and/or experience (boat tour, raft, etc.)

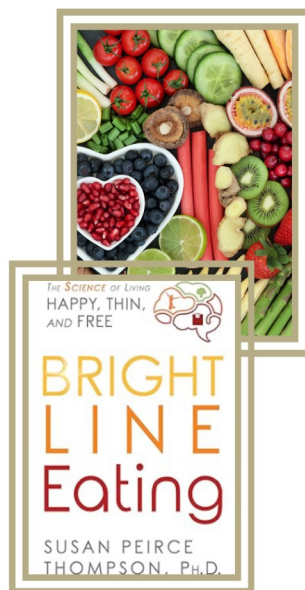
