They are so grateful for your spiritual and financial support!




St. Richard Music Ministry


OCIA Faith Formation

ONLY 80 TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE and this showing will NOT be open to the general public.


We will know the exact date, time, and price of ticket upon approval of the theater.
