Council of Catholic Women

All women of the parish are members of the Council of Catholic Women (CCW). This group supports, empowers and educates Catholic women in spirituality, leadership, and service, meeting the needs of the church and the local community. *Monthly meetings (Sept-June): 2nd Sunday of the month - after 10:00 Mass.*

Knights of Columbus

The Knights of Columbus is the historic Catholic men's organization. It's purpose is to render financial and other forms of aid to Catholic families in need by fund-raising and donating to charitable needs and projects. *Monthly evening meetings (Sept-June): 2nd Tuesday of the month.*

Religious Education (CGS, Elementary, Youth Group)

Every year our catechists work with your children to help them understand, love and become closer to Jesus. We make every effort to develop creative ways to engage your children in the Catholic faith. *Weekly meetings, October-May.*

Adult Formation - OCIA

The Adult Faith Formation ministry serves to engage the particular needs and interests of adults in our community. It employs prayer, liturgy, group Scripture study, catechetical-based programs, creative workshops, and fellowship to deepen one's relationship with God.

Music Ministry

The choir rehearses weekly and sings at the Sunday Masses. Anyone who can carry a tune or are willing to learn how, are welcome to join.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

An "Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion" is a Catholic lay person who assists in the distribution of Holy Communion during the Mass. *Training is required.*

Lector

Men and women with strong, easy-to-understand speaking voices are invited to serve as Lectors at Mass. *Training is provided.*

Greeters/Collection Ushers

These parishioners provide the ushering service at the celebration of Mass and other ceremonies. Their main task is to welcome all as they come to celebrate and to see to their needs. Other duties include taking up the collection, presenting the offertory gifts, and making sure the church is in order after Mass.

Ministry to the Homebound/Sick

These ministers have volunteered to bring the Body of Christ to those unable to receive in any other manner. This is truly a spiritually rewarding experience for all involved.

Prayer Chain

The purpose of the prayer chain is to offer anyone asking for prayer, the promise and commitment that their concerns will be lifted up to God in prayer by the prayer chain members.

Parish Social Hour (Coffee/Donuts) Hosts

This weekly fellowship social hour is a wonderful way to build community amongst parishioners. Duties include, preparing supplies, making coffee, and the general clean up of the tables and kitchen after the event. **Held after each Mass on Sunday mornings.*
