#### WHY DO WE DO THAT?

#### Questions about the Mass

It's Advent—a time of preparation for Christmas, when God the Son took on a human nature and became like one of us. This is such an incredible mystery and in the Mass, there is a prayer that is spoken by the priest or deacon that's a perfect meditation on this mystery.

When the altar is being prepared during the offertory, wine is poured in the chalice and then a drop of water is added. Why do we do that? The answer is found in the prayer: "By the mystery of



this water and wine, may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled Himself to share in our humanity." The mixture of the two points to what happened to Jesus at Christmas and to what happens to us when we receive communion. Jesus humbled Himself and made Himself small so that He could take our smallness and incorporate us into His greatness. "God became man, so that man could become God," as the Church Fathers put it. This is Good News! Through Jesus, in the Mass, we become like a drop of water in a chalice of wine, totally immersed and surrounded. But instead for us, we're immersed in Divinity, the life and presence of God.


