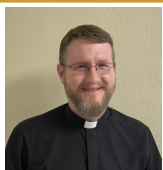

Pastor's Note

Happy Feast Day! Or at least happy early feast day! Today we're cele-

brating the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, under whose protection we as a parish remain and from whom we receive our name. Normally, this feast is celebrated on September 15th, the day after the Triumph of the Cross, when the Church remembers the work that Jesus did to save us and the call that we all have (His mother included) to pick up our own crosses and follow where our Master first walked. This title of Our Lady of Sorrows is one that history has given Mary due to her special connection to our Suffering Savior. And since she is our patroness, we've transferred the feast to Sunday to make it a big celebration. My hope is that today can be filled with joy and gratitude for our families, our faith, and most especially, our one parish and its two communities. It might seem strange to have joy on a day for Our Lady of Sorrows, but that's part of the Good News of Jesus Christ. He has conquered darkness, evil, the devil, and even death itself. We can have joy even when we suffer because He has won the war. Nothing should frighten, distress, or discourage us. Our God is with us, and His mother is praying for us. Rejoice! Be not afraid! And have a great feast day!

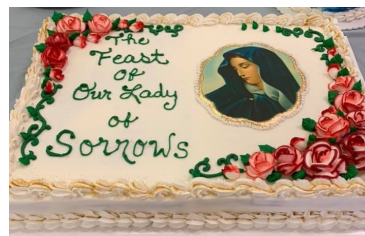

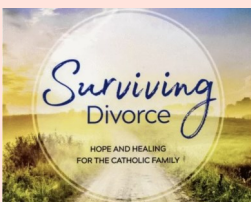

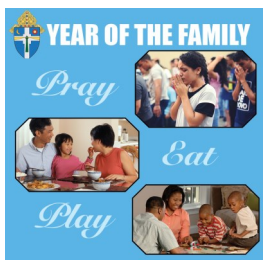
