

Pastor's Note

"Offer it up!" This is a phrase that many people were told when they were growing up. Every pain, discomfort, or suffering they experienced could be turned into a sacrifice to God, a

sacrifice of adoration offered for the redemption of others and our personal sanctification. If someone was caught complaining, they were told to "offer it up!" Unfortunately, I think many people have lost the practice of this important spiritual work. The more popular practice today is to blast all of our complaints on social media for the whole world to see, or to gossip about our discomforts and all the people who cause them. But what if in the silence of our prayers we lifted up our crosses to the Lord and asked Him to use our sufferings for the good of others? What if we suffered like Jesus? This Lent offer up your penances and disciplines to God. Even better, offer up your penances for somebody specific by name. Who needs to experience the Power of New Life in Jesus' Resurrection? Who is distant from the Lord and feels abandoned? Who is stuck in sin and addiction? Who is overwhelmed by violence and hatred? Let God use your penance for them. Offer it up for them.
