Our Lady of Sorrows/Capilla de Santísima Trinidad Memorial Garden Fundraiser/ Recaudación de Fondos de Jardín Conmemorativo



We are currently in the middle of approximately \$750,000 worth of major repair and renovation projects that have been long overdue – multiple air condition units in the OLS church and Trinity Hall, parking lot repairs, renovations at la Capilla, Social Center, and CCD Building; new gutters at multiple buildings; plumbing, sewer, and electrical repairs, and much more. So, how are we going to pay for this?

We have a plan. With your support and the Grace of God, we will successfully raise over 50% of this money through our Memorial Garden Projects. We have a total of 900 pavers, or bricks (but they're going quickly!), that are available for purchase to have engraved on them the name of a family or organization that you would like to honor. Each paver is 12X12X2 inches. The engraving will be limited to two lines with 14 characters per line. As shown in the picture above, the pavers of the cross area are \$500, and the regular pavers are \$300. You may make a payment plan, but once started, final payments will have a deadline and pavers will not be engraved until after final payment. The target date to start the construction of the Memorial Gardens is March 1, 2024. Order forms are in the front of the church and in the parish office. Thank you for your support!

Actualmente estamos en medio de aproximadamente \$ 750,000 en proyectos importantes de reparación y renovación que se han retrasado hace mucho tiempo: múltiples unidades de aire acondicionado en la iglesia OLS y Trinity Hall, reparaciones de estacionamiento, renovaciones en la Capilla, Centro Social y Edificio CCD; nuevas canaletas en varios edificios; plomería, alcantarillado y reparaciones eléctricas, y mucho más. Entonces, ¿cómo vamos a pagar por esto?

Tenemos un plan. Con su apoyo y la Gracia de Dios, recaudaremos con éxito más del 50% de este dinero a través de nuestros Proyectos de Jardines Conmemorativos. Tenemos un total de 900 adoquines, o ladrillos (ipero se van rápido!), que están disponibles para su compra para tener grabado en ellos el nombre de una familia u organización que le gustaría honrar. Cada pavimentadora mide 12X12X2 pulgadas. El grabado se limitará a dos líneas con 14 caracteres por línea. Como se muestra en la imagen de arriba, los adoquines del área transversal cuestan \$ 500 y los adoquines regulares cuestan \$ 300. Puede hacer un plan de pago, pero una vez iniciado, los pagos finales tendrán una fecha límite y los adoquines no se grabarán hasta después del pago final. La fecha objetivo para comenzar la construcción de los Jardines Memorial es el 1 de marzo de 2024.

What is a Rosary Congress?

The Diocesan Rosary Congress is a time of intense prayer before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament using the Holy Rosary to pray for needs of our family, our country and the world.

Baptism of Children/Bautismo de los Niños

If you would like to have your child baptized at our parish, please contact the office to begin the process. We will need the sacramental records of your child's godparents and your child's birth certificate. At least one of the Parents needs to be a baptized Catholic and registered in a Catholic parish somewhere. If you have completed the baptismal preparation, we will then schedule you for one of the days we offer baptisms—third Sundays in Spanish and fourth Sundays in English after the 2pm Mass.
