COVID RULES AND GUIDELINES issued to all Places of Worship by the Louisiana Department of Public Safety by the Louisiana Office of State Fire

Marshal.

There seems to be much confusion regarding the guidelines that we are following during the Covid Pandemic.

We must maintain Social Distancing, wear face mask and sanitize our hands as often as possible.

Crowd Managers are assigned to each service to enforce social distancing requirements, assign seating, take temperatures, and assure that everyone is wearing a face mask that covers the nose and mouth.

Crowd Managers arrive at church to open the foyer doors 30 minutes before the service. The reason for this is because we allow time for the church to be sanitized and for the sanitizing to be completely dried before allowing the next group in.

People are only allowed to enter the church through the foyer doors, so that we can be assured that everyone has their temperature taken.

As Bishop Marshall stated in a letter to the priests; "We claim to be a pro-life Church. Defeating COVID-19 is a pro-life issue. Many innocent lives have been lost because people cannot seem to wear a mask or keep their distance. True, we are grateful that most people recover from this disease – but that is not because a cure has been found. It is merely because their own health was strong enough to defeat the virus. That is not true for many among us – including the crowd who are regularly attending Mass. Too often, even in this pandemic, our pews are not filled with the young and the healthy but the elderly and the infirm. We wear masks and socially distance NOT to protect ourselves, but to protect the most vulnerable among us."

We fully understand your frustration, as no one is more frustrated than the staff. We are trying to do everything to keep you safe. Please be patient with us, as we are following the state and Diocesan guidelines.

We understand that other churches are not doing what we are doing, but we are following the guidelines put out by the State Fire Marshall and the Diocese of Alexandria. We cannot control what the other parishes are doing. -Fr. Raj
