

FROM THE DESK OF Fr. THOMAS KOYS, M.A., S.T.L., ASSOC. PASTOR

Whether or not you attend the first official Traditional Latin Mass (aka:TLM) at St James today, it most surely will be the talk of the town for many. We are most grateful to Bishop Joseph Perry for being here and offering this beautiful Mass. As many of us continue to learn how to attend the TLM properly and I, the priest, continue to learn how to do it properly, many thoughts rush through our minds. I wish to share a couple of mine.

Number one, you will inevitably hear the phrase "with his back to the people" in reference to how the priest stands during this Mass. For many St Jamesers, we know that this posture is known as "ad orientem," or towards the east. This posture is not exclusively for the TLM but is also most beautiful in the Vatican II Mass, (aka: Novus Ordo). When you hear someone say, "with his back to the people" hopefully, you can help them with something like this, "The priest isn't really turning his back on the people, he's turning his face towards God, since the tabernacle is then in front of him." Or how about this response: "Don't think of it as the priest is turning his back to the people, rather it's much better to think that the priest and laity are standing together, facing the same direction. This way, it is symbolic of the fact that the priest is a worshiper too."

Number two, you will inevitably hear it said, "How can you attend a Mass in a language you don't understand?" This is, admittedly a little harder to explain. But consider this, "Isn't faith prior to understanding". That is to say, like St Augustine said, "Theology is faith seeking understanding." He didn't say, "Religion is understanding seeking faith." Admittedly, sitting through a TLM with no idea of the words will be a formidable obstacle, but that's where the great modern

invention of the "book" comes in handy. Indeed, it's more than just handy, it's down-right necessary. I encourage one and all to purchase a TLM book for congregational participation. In reality, while the priest is saying the prayers and you are trying to follow along, you are opening your mind and heart to those prayers in a way that may even surpass your understanding of the English words in the Novus Ordo. Everyone knows, that seeing a word in print is more powerful than just hearing it audibly. When you read the prayers the meaning of the words sinks in more. You can even re-read something to appreciate the meaning better. Try stopping a priest in the regular Mass and asking him to start over again.

Finally, you may very well hear "That Mass is taking us backwards, we need to move forward as a church." To this comment it is only necessary to say "What part of empty seminaries, empty convents, empty pews, high divorce rates and millions of abortions annually have to do with moving the church forward?"
