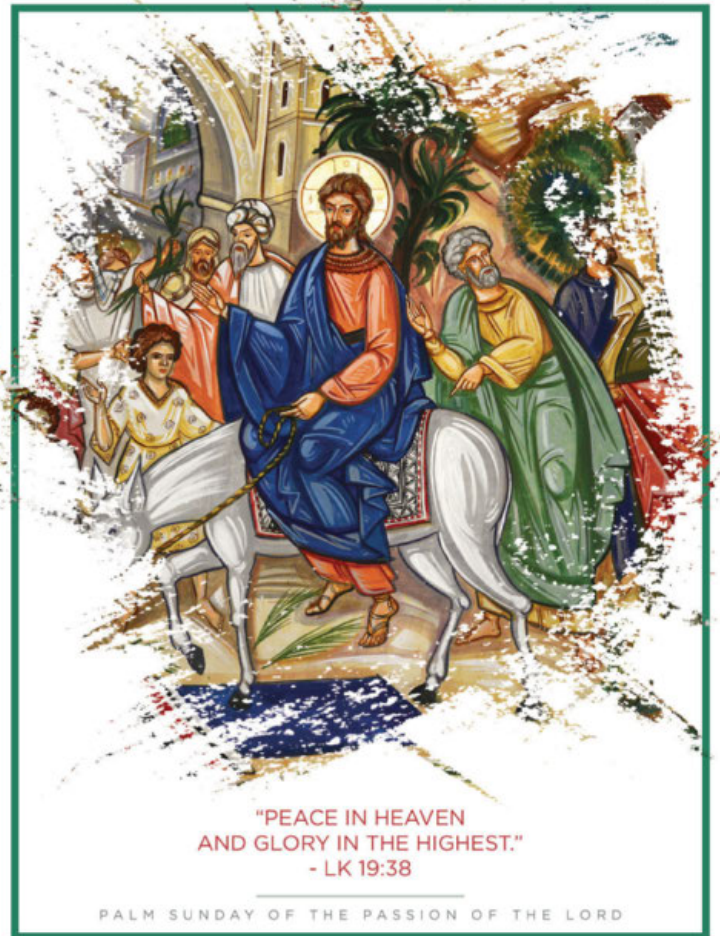

HYMNAL FUNDRAISING UPDATE

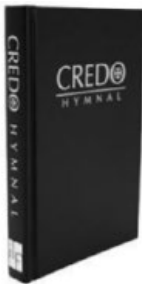
As of April 3, 520 out of 600 hymnals have been sponsored with dedications. This is 87% of our total goal. Thank you for your generosity and support!

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

GOOD FRIDAY (APRIL 15) TO
FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY (APRIL 24)



Jesus, our blessed Lord, instructed St. Faustina to make a Novena before the Feast of Mercy, beginning on Good Friday: "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fount of My Mercy, that they may draw from there strength and refreshment and whatever graces they need in the hardships of life and, especially at the hour of death."

"On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls and I will bring all these souls into the house of My Father." (Diary, 1209)

On Good Friday - April 15 - at Holy Family Church, immediately following Stations of the Cross at 3:00 pm, we will have the first day of this Novena. We will continue each day for nine days, ending on April 24 - the Feast of Divine Mercy.

"Souls who spread the honor of My Mercy I shield through their entire lives as a tender mother her infant, and at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior. At that last hour, a soul has nothing with which to defend itself except My Mercy. Happy is the soul that during its lifetime immersed itself in the Fountain of Mercy, because justice will have no hold on it." (Diary, 1075)

HOLY WEEK?

*Here are some practical suggestions for making this
Holy Week prayerful, fruitful, and edifying:*

- 1.) Plan on coming to daily Mass on Holy Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. It's only a half hour!
- 2.) Definitely plan on attending the solemn liturgies of the Sacred Triduum. These are the richest liturgies of the entire year - they are ancient and very moving. Re-arrange your schedule if you need to, but plan on coming!
- 3.) Make a good confession. We all need it. All of us.
- 4.) If you can, come to Stations of the Cross at 3pm on Good Friday. It's the hour of our salvation!
- 5.) Do not schedule anything on Holy Saturday. Use the day for quiet prayer and contemplation. The Lord is in the tomb and the whole world is silent - we should be too.
- 6.) Fast and abstain on Good Friday. Go harder than what the Church obliges if you can. How about a water fast?
- 7.) Plan on doing something particularly sacrificial. Maybe make a monetary donation that stings a bit or the like.
- 8.) Pray the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet every day.
- 9.) Spend some serious time with the scripture readings each day.
- 10.) Plan to celebrate BIG after the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday. Fasting must be followed by feasting!
