Dear St. Brigid School Community,

This Sunday morning at 9:30 at St. Pius X Church, we will be celebrating the Mass of the Holy Spirit. All members of the school community are invited to attend this Mass that traditionally opens the academic year at schools all over the world.

On Monday, September 15, at 8:45 AM the school will celebrate its first all-school mass of the 2025-2026 academic year in St. Joseph's Church. If a student arrives late to Mass, parents must sign the child in at the main office and then escort their child to the glass doors of the church, located on the right side of the church, facing Stevens Avenue, to gain admittance.
