Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

- Parents may park in the rear parking lot or along Stevens Avenue, but we ask that all campers are accompanied by a parent to the designated drop-off area between 8:00 am –

8:30 am. Weather dependent, the designated drop-off areas are the playground or the Dolly Foster gym.

- Pick-up will consist of the same steps as drop-off in which parents walk to the designated areas and pick-up your camper between 2:30 pm and 3:00 pm.
 - o Any late pick-ups will be charged \$3 per minute after 3:00 pm on days that apply.
- If your camper will not be attendance, arrive late, or be dismissed early, please call or text the SBS Summer Camp phone (207-210-5429).

Clothing/Sunscreen:

- Campers should wear clothing that is conducive to outdoor play, including running, climbing, and jumping. Sneakers are highly recommended for the safest outdoor play.
- To plan for weather or water activities, we ask families to pack a bag filled with extra clothing items (shirt, bottom, socks, etc.). This bag will remain at school for the entirety of the two-week camp, except for times that those clothes being used.
 - o In case of water play, please have your children bring some type of “water shoe”, this can be crocs, flip-flops, or slides. Since we have our water play in the park behind the church, there is a chance of sticks and rocks.
- Each day, provide a bottle/can of sunscreen for your child that is properly labeled with their name on it.
 - o Parent permission is required for staff to assist with the application of sunscreen throughout camp.

Snacks/Lunch:

- Please pack your camper daily snacks as well as a water bottle that is clearly labeled with their name.
- Campers should bring a home lunch daily except for the last Friday of camp, June 19th. Pizza will be served on that day.
 - o If your camper has any allergies or concern of allergies, please provide them with a packed lunch on that day.

Payment Obligations:

- A non-refundable deposit of \$340 per student is charged upon registration and due on March 6, 2026. The remaining balance of \$340 will be due by May 29, 2026. If the balance remains unpaid, your camper will not be able to attend camp.
