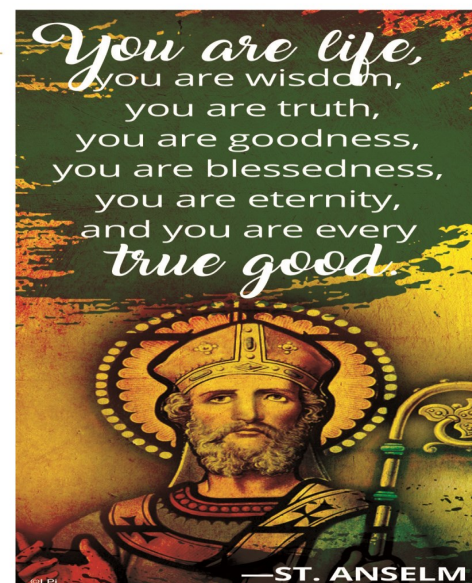

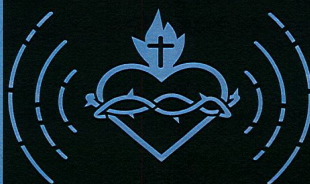

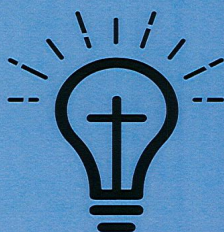

A Note from the Diocese of Dallas on Children Sacraments and Faith Formation

Please be aware that only a parent or legal guardian may arrange for the sacraments, or faith formation, of a minor child. It must be confirmed that any person registering a minor child for continuing faith formation, or sacramental preparation, has the legal authority to do so. If that adult's name is not reflected on the child's birth certificate, or in the case of an already baptized minor child, on the baptismal certificate, the person must provide the proper documentation that shows he/she has the legal right to arrange for the spiritual needs of the child.

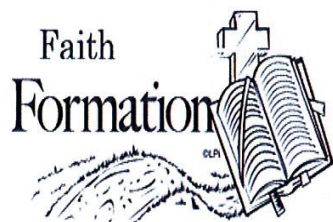

Debe confirmarse que cualquier persona que inscriba a un menor de edad para continuar su Formación de Fe, o preparación sacramental, tiene la autoridad legal para hacerlo. Si el nombre de ese adulto no está reflejado en el certificado de nacimiento del niño, o en el caso de un niño menor de edad bautizado, en el certificado de bautismo, la persona debe proporcionar la documentación adecuada que demuestre que tiene el derecho legal de organizar lo espiritual necesidades del niño.

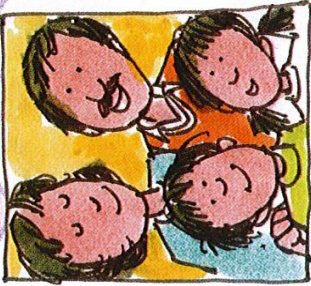

On the front of this leaflet is a simple

Act of Faith. Cut out the prayer and hang it in an obvious place, where all can say the prayer daily. Incorporate this prayer in a prayer service. Follow the simple steps below for your prayer service.

1 From the psalms, choose an opening intercession and response. You can use the responsorial psalm from this Sunday's Mass, but any appropriate short passage asking God to hear your prayers will do.

2 Select a Scripture reading that speaks to you of faith. Today's gospel is a good one but there may be others that are special to your family. All of Christ's miracles are responses to the faith of the people involved.

3 Recite together the Act of Faith from the front of this leaflet.

4 Have each member of the family write a one-line prayer asking God for faith and help in a current difficulty. All answer each prayer with "Lord, hear our prayer" or a similar response.

5 Let your closing prayer be a spontaneous outpouring of thanksgiving to the Father for Jesus and for the faith of your family. Each member should have an opportunity to add his or her thanks to this prayer.

6 Use your imagination to make your service more special with candles, songs, or decorations.

A Terrible Storm

You are Peter in the gospel story. You are in a boat with your friends, far, far out from the shore. The water is deep and icy cold.

Suddenly a storm comes up! The boat rocks back and forth, first this way, then that way. You hold on tight to the side so you won't fall into the lake! You are frightened! Your friends are frightened! What will you do? Who will help you?

Then you remember God, and you pray — very hard. Look! See who is coming toward you? It's Jesus, walking atop the stormy lake! "Lord, is it really you?" you call out. And Jesus calls you to him. You step out of the boat and begin to walk on the water. You trust Jesus. He won't let you drown.

But then you think about it. "This is impossible!" you think, "I can't do this!" You begin to sink into the water. Jesus reaches out and helps you. "Truly," your friends tell Jesus, "you are the Son of God."

Wasn't that a scary experience? Sometimes, when things go wrong, you may feel helpless. When something is very hard, you may think, "I can't do this!"

Remember the lesson Peter learned. *Jesus is truly God!* He can walk on water. He can calm the storms of your life and make things right again.
