

From the Desk of the Pastor

This week we celebrate Catholic Schools Week. How important a Catholic education is! We are faced with the challenge of keeping our youth in the Church. Statistics for the Pittsburgh area are staggering: 20% of children baptized do not make their First Holy Communion and 85% of children confirmed stop practicing their faith by the age of 21. We must reverse this trend! Catholic school students are more likely to pray daily, attend church more often, retain a Catholic identity as an adult, and donate more to the Church. It's also important to add that during the March shutdown, within two weeks our Regional Schools had virtual classrooms established and have been in-person since September, with the addition of hybrid learning. Very few other schools can say the same. Please support our five schools this week in some way! See www.NHRCES.org for more details.

And speaking of a Catholic education, I need to add some to your current world. Let me explain what that might be. There are two notices for you.

The first, on Wednesday, February 3rd, we celebrate the Memorial of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. It is traditionally a time to bless throats. Well, thanks to COVID, we are not permitted to offer individual blessings. Therefore, the 8am and 7pm Masses will conclude with a general blessing to all in attendance. Sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

The second learning is much harder... On February 17th, we celebrate Ash Wednesday. This day begins our Lenten journey. Well, thanks to COVID, the distribution of ashes will take place in a different way. It is tradition in other parts of the world to SPRINKLE ashes on the recipient, rather than imposing them on the forehead. So, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked the country to do the same. As I often preach, there is no magic in the ashes nor are they a badge of honor. Lent begins on the 17th no matter what! Be prepared, as I was taught many years ago in the Boy Scouts.

In the hopes of getting back to a somewhat normal world, be reminded that we have contracted with ACCESS for those who can't drive and wish to get to Mass, confession or any event at any of our churches. If you are interested, please contact Anna Trovato at extension 362. You will need to show proof of age, via a driver's license or similar, which will be kept on file. The Knights of Columbus Art J. Rooney, Sr. Council #9984 has offered a grant to users of ACCESS. They have given ten \$50.00 "vouchers" for parishioners who utilize this service. What this means is that there is no cost to the parishioner for this service, i.e., FREE! So, what a deal! Please, consider taking advantage of this opportunity.

Some biographical highlights: Fr. Joseph was born in Columbus, OH, and was raised in Canton, OH. He earned his Bachelor's degree in 1989 from Borromeo College Seminary. In 1990, he professed his first vows as a Capuchin Franciscan friar. Making his Perpetual vows in 1993, he went on to earn his Master's degree in theology in 1995 and was ordained in 1997. His first assignment was in Papua, New Guinea where he served for four years. Returning to the US in 2001, he has served in various capacities as parochial vicar, pastor, military and hospital chaplain and has also served in Puerto Rico. He currently serves as the national director of the Archconfraternity of Christian Mothers and in fulltime preaching ministry for the Capuchin Province of St. Augustine, offering retreats and reflection days for parishes, Religious and Priests.

BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. Call the parish office for details.

RECONCILIATION: See the front cover page for times in our grouping. Other times are available by appointment.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact the parish's faith formation office for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact the parish office for details.

CONFIRMATION: Children preparing for confirmation are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Any adult (over 18) should contact the faith formation office for details and registration.

MARRIAGE: Potential couples wishing to be married in the Catholic Church must contact the Priest or Deacon at least six months before the desired date. No date can be guaranteed until the couple has met with one of the parish priests. Please start with contacting the Priest or Deacon you wish to witness your marriage.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK: This sacrament is administered by a Priest and is preferred when the recipient is aware of its healing power. Communal Anointing of the Sick Masses are offered during the year - in the fall and in the spring in one of our churches.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is open to any adult interested in becoming a Roman Catholic Christian through a program of formation and prayer. Call the faith formation office for details and registration.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP: New parishioners are always welcome! Call the parish office for a census form.

CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES LAW

Any individuals, paid or volunteer, who come into contact with children in the course of his or her work are considered mandated reporters of child abuse. Mandated reporters having reasonable cause to believe that a child has been subjected to child abuse, or acts of child abuse, shall report immediately to the following agencies:
