

From the Desk of the Pastor

Just a reminder that tomorrow is Memorial Day. While the tradition of decorating graves of soldiers is quite ancient, Memorial Day has become a national day to recognize the brave men and women who paid the ultimate sacrifice by dying in battle to protect the freedoms we have. Let us make sure that we honor these fallen while we eat a few hotdogs and hamburgers to begin summer. May these brave women and men rest in peace. There will be one Mass tomorrow at 9:00 am at St. Aloysius. All are welcome.

As you may recall, each year there is the **Missionary Cooperation Plan Collection**. It is our opportunity to support the work of the missions throughout the world. Due to the pandemic, there will NOT be a missionary speaking at our Masses the weekend of June 5-6. A member of the Clergy Team will be reading the prepared statement from the society benefiting from our generosity. This year, the Diocese for some reason has split our campaigns. The monies collected at **AS**, **HS**, and **SA** will benefit the **Apostles of Jesus** founded in 1968 in Uganda to evangelize the native people. The monies collected at **SB** will benefit the **Missionary Society of St. Paul of Nigeria** whose project is rescuing young boys between the ages of 10-15 from the streets. We ask that you be generous to these causes in the special second collection that will be taken up NEXT WEEKEND, 5-6 June, at all the Masses.

This Tuesday evening, I will be heading to the WPXI studios with a few parishioners to record the TV Mass for Shut-Ins. It will broadcast on Sunday, 13 June at 6:00 am on PCNC and MeTV (check local listings for channel numbers). It's always a challenge to fit Mass into the 28 minute and 15 second time slot! The last time I was there, the director shared with me the signals for "speed up" and "slow-down" before we began taping. No problem. After Communion he gave me a signal that was neither of the ones he had shared! Afterwards, I was, "What was that???" We still giggle about it. However, I was within the time frame.

In the hopes of getting back to a somewhat normal world, be reminded that we have contracted with ACCESS for those who can't drive and wish to get to Mass, confession or any event at any of our four churches. If you are interested, please contact Anna Trovato at extension 362. You will need to show proof of age, via a driver's license or similar, which will be kept on file. The Knights of Columbus Art J. Rooney, Sr. Council #9984 has offered a grant to users of ACCESS. They have given ten \$50.00 "vouchers" for parishioners who utilize this service. What this means is that there is no cost to the parishioner for this service, i.e., FREE! So, what a deal! Please, consider taking advantage of this opportunity.

Everything in Its Right Place:

Choosing Music for the Liturgy



We read in the third chapter of the book of Ecclesiastes, "There is an appointed time for everything, and a time for every affair under the heavens." Music for the sacred liturgy is no exception, but how do

we know how to put everything where it belongs? Have you ever wondered how the music ministry team chooses music for Mass? One frequently consulted resource is the liturgical document *Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship. Sing to the Lord* lays out three judgments that answer the question, "Does this music make sense for this part of the liturgy?" Each of the three judgments are of equal importance in the process of choosing music that complements, and never distracts from, the liturgy.

The Liturgical Judgment considers whether the music follows the church's instructions for a particular rite or part of the Mass. Do the piece of music and its text "fit" what the liturgical documents prescribe? The Pastoral Judgment asks what works for a particular congregation. It allows a bit of license to curate musical selections that incorporate local cultures, traditions, and preferences, but never loses sight of the question, "Does this music draw us closer to the mystery of Christ?" The Musical Judgment asks if a piece of music is sufficiently dignified to hold a place within the liturgy. That said, it does not discriminate based on genre-- it encourages a "balanced diet" of all styles, tailored to the needs of each particular liturgy and congregation.

BAPTISM: Prior registration is necessary. A formation session for parents is also required. All paperwork needs to be on hand prior to scheduling. Call Carol at ext. 380.

RECONCILIATION: See the front cover page for times in our grouping. Other times are available by appointment.

FIRST COMMUNION: First Holy Communion is usually celebrated in the Spring. Children candidates are expected to be enrolled in the parish faith formation program. Contact Louis at ext. 413 for details and registration.

HOME BOUND: Upon request, Holy Communion can be brought to the home by the Priest, Deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. Contact Elaine at ext. 419.
