



From the Desk of the Pastor

This week the US celebrates Catholic Schools Week. We are privileged to not only have one Catholic school in our parish but FIVE as part of the North Hills Regional Catholic Elementary Schools. As I've mentioned previously, our financial stake is moving more toward the region than just Blessed Trinity Academy. I see that as important because we currently have students in four of the five regional schools! I highly recommend that you consider a Catholic education for the children in your life. There's more to it than just the faith aspect. I look back to March 2020. While all the public districts were befuddled as to how education was going to happen, within two weeks of the shutdown, our five schools were up and running remotely. In the fall of 2020, as the public schools were STILL trying to figure out what to do, our five schools just kept on teaching remotely. As soon as it was safe for our students to return to the classroom, boom! they were in the classroom. Our five schools have missed very few beats. We should be overjoyed and proud of our Catholic Schools for that and so many other reasons! That's why I'm a fan of ALL of our North Hills Regional Catholic Elementary Schools!

Last week, I mentioned Fr. Coriden's four categories of parishioners. I see the "seasonal" and lapsed quite often. How's that you wonder? At weddings and funerals! I know my brothers and I become so frustrated when we say: "The Lord be with you, you, you, you..." to no response whatsoever! I've said a couple of times we need to either return the ministry of the commentator (someone who gives commentary and/or directions) or to have a "Greek chorus" (a group that responds in unison throughout the Mass). In the meantime, I'd encourage you to "crash" wedding ceremonies and Funeral Masses! My brothers and I could really use your help!

An item from the Advisory Council Meeting the other week questioned the continuing presence of our COVID pew colors for physical distancing at Mass. I say that they need to stay. Why? I know how my luck is! The split-second they are removed is the exact moment we will tragically take a step backward in our progression out of COVID requiring their return! I know that's a lame excuse. However, that's my story and I'm sticking to it! Let's hope that one day soon they can be safely removed!

In today's bulletin is a financial report for the Rummage House. Realize that profit is via A LOT of quarters and dollars! I am so grateful to Claire Sigmund and the crew for the unsung work they do - sorting, pricing, selling. Thanks too to those who donate. I KNOW they would appreciate additional volunteers. I need to volunteer! Let's help continue keeping it the success that it is!

Be reminded that we have contracted with ACCESS for those who can't drive and wish to get to Mass, confession or any event at any of our four churches. Rooney, Sr. Council #9984 has offered a grant to users of ACCESS. They have given ten \$50.00 "vouchers" for parishioners who utilize this service. What this means is that there is no cost to the parishioner for this service, i.e., FREE! So, what a deal! Please, consider taking advantage of this opportunity.

CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES LAW

Any individuals, paid or volunteer, who come into contact with children in the course of his or her work are considered mandated reporters of child abuse. Mandated reporters having reasonable cause to believe that a child has been subjected to child abuse, or acts of child abuse, shall report immediately to the following agencies:

- If you suspect a child is in imminent danger from abuse, please call 911 immediately.
- Children and Youth Services: 412-473-2000
- Abuse Hotline: 800-932-0313

Anyone making a report is immune from civil or criminal liability provided a report is made in good faith.

DIOCESAN TOLL-FREE NUMBER FOR ABUSE RESPONSE:


