

STAND FIRM IN THE LORD

It is not hard to imagine, in this age of wars, evil groups bent on the destruction of humanity, and political follies, that the words of Saint Paul were so accurate, even for his time. It seems that the world never changes. Paul says, "Many . . . conduct themselves as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is their destruction . . . Their minds are occupied with earthly things" (Philippians 3:18, 19). The result is the destruction of innocent people and of the Earth itself. But Paul says to the Philippians, "our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we also await a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ" (3:20). He will "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (3:21). Note that he says "body" rather than "bodies." He is talking about the whole community of believers, who, following the example of Jesus and of Paul, will come into the glory of God. So "stand firm in the Lord" (4:1). Copyright © J. S. MANTENTE FIRME EN EL SEÑOR

No es difícil imaginar, en esta época de guerras, que grupos malvados tiendan a la destrucción de la humanidad y locuras políticas, que las palabras de san Pablo fueron tan precisas, aún para el tiempo en que vivió. Pareciera que el mundo nunca cambia. Pablo dice "muchos se comportan como enemigos de la cruz de Cristo. Para los que piensan en cosas terrenas, su destino es la perdición. . . (Filipenses 3: 18, 19). El resultado es la destrucción de personas inocentes y del planeta mismo. Pero Pablo dice a los filipenses: "somos ciudadanos del cielo, de donde esperamos como salvador a Jesucristo el Señor" (3:20). Él "transformará nuestro cuerpo frágil en un cuerpo glorioso semejante al suyo" (3:21). Nota que él dice "cuerpo" en lugar de "cuerpos". Él habla acerca de la completa comunidad de creyentes, quienes, siguiendo el ejemplo de Jesús y Pablo, vendrán a la gloria de Dios. Así que "imanteránse firmes en el Señor!" (4:1). Copyright © J. S. Shortly after becoming Bishop of Lake Charles, Bishop Provost instituted the practice of 40 Hours Devotion of Prayer before the Most Blessed Sacrament. It occurs year-round throughout the Diocese. It will soon be our turn to host this devotion.

40 Hours Devotion will be at St. Henry's the week of April 1-5.

Please sign up to spend time adoring Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Our Lord cannot be left alone while He is exposed on the altar. Someone must be present in adoration at all times.

There are binders on the tables in all three lobbies of the church where you can sign up. Please put your name and phone number next to dates and times that you can adore. By all means, you can come more than once! You can also call the church office to sign up.

When Bishop Provost first instituted 40 Hours Devotion, the intention was to pray for vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life in our Diocese. Those prayers are bearing fruit as each year we have a good number of seminarians. This past year, we even had a priest ordained from St. Henry's for the first time. We must continue to pray and work for vocations.

In his Advent Decree on Prayer and Worship, Bishop Provost expanded the intentions of 40 Hours Devotion to also include prayers in reparation for sins contrary to the Sixth Commandment, the healing of all victims of sexual abuse, and the conversion of sinners.

Cuando el Obispo Provost instituyó por primera vez las 40 horas de devoción, la intención era de orar por las vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa en nuestra Diócesis. Esas oraciones están dando fruto ya que cada año tenemos un buen número de seminaristas. El año pasado, incluso tuvimos un sacerdote ordenado de San Henry por primera vez. Debemos seguir orando y trabajando por las vocaciones.

En su decreto de Adviento sobre la oración y la adoración, el Obispo Provost amplió las intenciones de 40 horas de dedicación para incluir también las oraciones en reparación por los pecados contrarios al Sexto Mandamiento, la sanación de todas las víctimas del abuso sexual y la conversión de los pecadores.


