THE PRESENCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We have a unique episode in the Acts of the Apostles today. A whole roomful of people are baptized with the Holy Spirit before they are baptized with water! The verb used—"the Holy Spirit 'fell' on them" (Acts 10:44)—is characteristic of the way the Spirit works throughout the book of Acts: powerful and surprising. Though this "baptism" is not the normative way the New Testament describes baptism, it is still a good reminder today that the Holy Spirit is not controlled by whether or not we pour water, but rather that our sacramental signs reveal the presence of the Spirit at work among us. And we have a double reinforcement of how this work is accomplished from a Letter and a Gospel bearing John's name. It is love, self-sacrificing and self-giving love, that manifests the Spirit of Jesus in our midst. It is love that is the greatest of commandments. Y tenemos un doble refuerzo de cómo esta obra se lleva a cabo en la carta y el Evangelio que llevan el nombre de Juan. Es el amor, el auto sacrificio y el amor de entrega, que manifiestan al Espíritu de Jesús entre nosotros. El amor es el más grande de los mandamientos. PARROQUIAL VICAR'S MESSAGE — FR. JOSEPH CARAWAY

Our Lady of Fatima

So many of us are familiar with the name "Fatima," as the small town where Mary appeared to the three young children and performed the great miracle of the sun. However, the name, "Fatima" has a history. The location of Mary's appearance got its name from a Muslim princess by the name of Fatima, who fell in love with a Christian knight. This name is renowned to Muslims because it was the name of Muhammad's daughter. The princess converted to Catholicism and married the knight, but shortly after they married, she passed away and her husband named the place of her burial after her.

There are many other places and children that Mary could have appeared to, but she appeared in a place with Muslim roots. The fact that she appeared to the children in that location is not inconsequential. We can learn several things from Our Lady of Fatima like the reality of Hell, the power of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the importance of the rosary, the penance and the sufferings of the Church, and many others. The fact that she appeared in a place with the name, Fatima, shows us that she desires not only Christians, but the entire world to her Son.

The name "Fatima," translated in English means "captivating" or "the one who weans an infant." As Catholics, I think we all agree that Mary fits the meaning of captivating. Mary also fits the meaning of "the one who weans an infant." In older customs, a wet nurse would wean a child from its mothers' milk, and while wet nurses are not common today, parents still wean their children from milk to normal food. Mary is our mother who is weaning us from the passing food of this world to the food of eternity. Mary's first appearance to the Children was May 13, 1917, and at that time, that was the liturgical celebration of Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament. This is not a coincidence. She is our mother who weans us from lesser goods of the world, to the eternal food of her Son, Jesus Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Like all good mothers who wants what is best for her children, Mary wants to bring us all to her Son and feed us on his eternal body and blood. No matter our background or upbringing. There is nothing better for us and more fulfilling than the eternal heavenly banquet. There is nothing, not even good things, that should come between our burning desire for heaven. Francisco, the 9-year-old visionary in Fatima, understood this from his encounters of Mary. When he was asked multiple times about what he wanted to be when he grew up, he responded, "I don't want to be anything. I want to die and go to heaven..." This is the ultimate message of Fatima, to die and go to heaven as a Saint. This must be our greatest desire for ourselves and the world. Furthermore, it must be more than just a desire, it must be a belief that changes the way we live.

Nuestra Señora de Fatima

Muchos de nosotros estamos familiarizados con el nombre de "Fátima", como el pequeño pueblo donde María apareció a los tres niños pequeños y realizó el gran milagro del sol. Sin embargo, el nombre "Fátima" tiene una historia. La ubicación de la aparición de María recibió su nombre de una princesa musulmana con el nombre de Fátima, que se enamoró de un caballero cristiano. Este nombre es conocido por los musulmanes porque era el nombre de la hija de Muhammad. La princesa se convirtió al catolicismo y se casó con el caballero, pero poco después de casarse, ella falleció y su marido nombró el lugar de su entierro en su honor.

Hay muchos otros lugares y niños a los que María podría haberse aparecido, pero ella apareció en un lugar con raíces musulmanas. El hecho de que ella se le apareciera a los niños en ese lugar no es intrascendente. Podemos aprender varias cosas de nuestra Señora de Fátima como la realidad del Infierno, el poder del corazón Inmaculado de María, la importancia del rosario, la penitencia y los sufrimientos de la Iglesia, y muchas otras. El hecho de que ella apareció en un lugar con el nombre de Fátima, nos muestra que ella quiere no solo a los Cristianos, sino al mundo entero para su Hijo.

El nombre "Fátima", traducido en inglés significa "cautivante" o "quien desteta a un bebé". Como católicos, creo que todos estamos de acuerdo en que María encaja en el significado de cautivar. María también encaja con el significado de "quien desteta a un bebé". En las costumbres más viejas, una nodriza destetaba a un niño de la leche de sus madres, y mientras que las nodrizas no son comunes hoy en día, los padres todavía destetan a sus hijos de la leche a la comida normal. María es nuestra madre que nos desteta de la comida que hay en este mundo al alimento de la vida eterna. La primera aparición de María a los niños fue el 13 de mayo de 1917, y ese momento, esa fue la celebración litúrgica de Nuestra Señora del Santísimo Sacramento. Esto no es una coincidencia. Ella es nuestra madre que nos desteta de bienes menores del mundo, al alimento eterno de su Hijo Jesucristo en el Santísimo Sacramento.

Como todas las buenas madres que quieren lo mejor para sus hijos, María quiere traernos a todos a su Hijo y alimentarnos de su Cuerpo y Sangre eternas. No importa nuestros antecedentes o educación. No hay nada mejor para nosotros y más satisfactorio que el eterno banquete celestial. No hay nada, ni siquiera cosas buenas, que deba venir entre nuestro ardiente deseo del cielo. Francisco, el visionario de 9 años en Fátima, lo entendió a partir de sus encuentros con María. Cuando se le preguntó varias veces sobre lo que quería ser cuando creciera, él respondió: "No quiero ser nada. Quiero morir e ir al cielo..." Este es el mensaje final de Fátima, morir e ir al cielo como Santo. Este debe ser nuestro mayor deseo para nosotros y para el mundo. Además, debe ser algo más que un deseo, debe ser una creencia que cambie la forma en que vivimos.

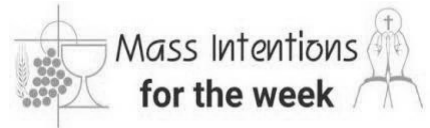
