PASTOR'S MESSAGE — Matthew Cormier**GIVING BACK**

Last summer, we were the beneficiaries of the kindness and generosity of people from all over Louisiana and beyond. With our neighbors to the East recently suffering the devastating effects of Hurricane Ida, it was our turn to give back.

Over the weekend of September 11-12, parishioners dropped off supplies. On Thursday September 16th, Fr. Caraway and myself led a crew of nine parishioners from St. Henry's to St. Ann Catholic Church in Bourg, Louisiana who unloaded and distributed those supplies and served 250 meals that had been cooked by the Knights of St. Peter Claver. St. Henry's St. Vincent de Paul account donated \$1,500 to St. Ann Church. *South Side Machine Works, Inc.* which is owned by parishioners of St. Henry's generously donated 325 gallons of gasoline and cooked and served another 250 meals.

Mrs. Lisa Lapeyrouse, the Director of Youth Formation at St. Ann's, sent the following message of thanks to be shared with the parishioners of St. Henry's:

"Thank you from the bottom of our hearts for the outpouring of love to the people of Bourg... the food filled our bellies... your supplies filled our homes and places of refuge... and your love and care for us thru financial donations filled us with hope and will bless many people in need.

To the crew that came to Bourg today... lots of things filled my heart today, but two things pushed me over the edge... when the men picked up all of our yucky wet garbage and filled the truck with it to take home.... and when Father Joseph took the time to comfort and pray with one of our parishioners in need. You guys are all the absolute best!

Please know we are forever grateful and y'all will be in our daily prayers!"

El verano pasado, fuimos los beneficiarios de la amabilidad y generosidad de personas de todo Louisiana y más allá. Con nuestros vecinos del Este sufriendo recientemente los efectos devastadores del huracán Ida, fue nuestro turno de dar de vuelta.

Durante el fin de semana del 11 al 12 de septiembre, los feligreses dejaron suministros. El jueves 16 de septiembre, el Padre Caraway y yo dirigimos a un equipo de nueve feligreses de San Henry a la Iglesia Católica de San Ann en Bourg, Louisiana, quienes descargaron y distribuyeron esos suministros y sirvieron 250 platos de comida que fueron cocinadas por los Caballeros de San Pedro Claver. La cuenta de San Henry de San Vincente de Paul donó \$1,500 a la Iglesia de San Ann. *South Side Machine Works, Inc.*, que es propiedad de feligreses de San Henry generosamente donaron 325 galones de gasolina y cocinaron y sirvieron 250 platos de comida.

La Sra. Lisa Lapeyrouse, Directora de Formación Juvenil de San Ann, envió el siguiente mensaje de agradecimiento para compartir con los feligreses de San Henry:

"Gracias desde el fondo de nuestros corazones por la efusión de amor a la gente de Bourg... la comida nos llenó el vientre... sus suministros llenaron nuestros hogares y lugares de refugio... y su amor y cuidado por nosotros a través de donaciones financieras nos llenó de esperanza y bendecirá a muchas personas necesitadas.

Para el equipo que vino a Bourg hoy... muchas cosas llenaron mi corazón hoy, pero dos cosas me llevaron al límite... cuando los hombres recogieron toda nuestra basura mojada y llenaron el camión con ella para llevársela con ellos.... y cuando el Padre Joseph se tomó el tiempo para consolar y orar con uno de nuestros feligreses necesitados. ¡Todos ustedes son los mejores!



She has been in the Catholic music ministry for over 20 years and has sold more than 100,000 CDs.

Donna’s songs are sung by other parish ministries at Masses and gatherings across the nation. Most popular are her Sung Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Musical Rosary, and prayers of the saints. Originally from New York’s secular music market, she realized that the music she was producing only served to distract people from life’s true goal, which is to “love God with your whole heart, soul, mind, and strength.”


We will meet in the area on the west side of the Civic Center and organize in groups of 11 to form a Living Rosary.
