FAMILY LIFE

Christmas celebrates the Incarnation, the “en-fleshment” of God as a human person. In Jesus, God is bodily present in the human story. Today we honor the Holy Family, helping us to see that God is active in daily family life. God is near at hand, amidst the tensions, joys, and uncertainties of family life. As our Gospel passage describes, even with family miscommunications and with limited understanding of Jesus’ mission, the Holy Family persevered in their life together. Like many family conflicts, there was no immediate or clear resolution of the issues raised by Jesus and by Mary. God’s intentions for the family, and for Jesus, were still unfolding. They continued to stay connected with each other and with God. Within the turbulence of family life, they trusted God to actively sustain and guide them into an uncertain future. We are invited to follow their example.

VIDA FAMILIAR

La Navidad celebra la Encarnación, la “en-carna-ción” de Dios como una persona humana. En Jesús, Dios está presente físicamente en la historia humana. Hoy honramos a la Sagrada Familia, que nos ayuda a ver que Dios está activo en la vida familiar cotidiana. Dios está cerca, en medio de las tensiones, alegrías y las incertidumbres de la vida familiar. Como lo describe nuestro pasaje del Evangelio, incluso con la falta de comunicación y con una limitada comprensión de la misión de Jesús, la Sagrada Familia perseveró en su vida en común. Como en muchos conflictos familiares, no hubo una resolución inmediata o clara en los asuntos presentados por Jesús y María. Las intenciones de Dios hacia la familia y hacia Jesús, seguían desarrollándose. Ellos eran una familia unida y también lo eran con Dios. Dentro de la turbulencia de la vida familiar, confiaron en que Dios los sostenía vivamente y guía ba a un futuro incierto. Estamos invitados a seguir su ejemplo.

The Christmas Octave

The other day, my six-year-old nephew saw a commercial for the newest toy, and of course, he had to have it. He asked his mom if she would buy the toy, but she responded, “maybe for Christmas.” Unsatisfied with the answer, he responded, “It is Christmas, Mom! It is the Christmas month, so I should be able to have it.”

Deep down, we all want to extend a holiday or birthday celebration. It is common to hear people joke about their birthday month or birthday week. The same thing happens for Christmas. There is something the human person intuits about a special feast that it cannot be contained in one day. The Church would agree that special feasts like Christmas and Easter cannot be contained in one day. The celebration overflows to eight days of celebration. Hence the term “octave” which means “eight.”

Unfortunately, the secular society starts celebrating Christmas the day after Thanksgiving. This intention is not malicious, and people want to extend the celebration, but the highest celebration should come the day of Christmas and the seven days that follow. We do not want to lose steam by the time the real Christmas season arrives.

In the eyes of the Church, She celebrates Christmas day for eight days straight in solemnity celebration. While most people are reducing their celebration, the Church is still exalting the Christ child. In the spirit of the Church, this great feast of redemption should not be restricted to a single day but should continue through a full week. We cannot impress upon our soul the great mystery of Christmas in a single day. It takes time to reflect and let the great mystery sink into our soul and understanding.

While this celebration for eight days helps a person enter the mystery of Christ coming into the world, the eighth day of this octave is concluded with a special solemnity. Christmas is about the Christ child coming into the world, but we remember the vessel and how he came to us through Mary. Therefore, on January 1, the eighth day and conclusion of the octave, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.

While we all joke about our birthday week knowing that we are not deserving, Christ is deserving of a week of celebration. This is exactly what the Church does to rejoice Jesus’ birthday and it ends with the celebration of his Mother. For this Christmas Octave, be sure to keep the fervor of celebration with family and friends and try to attend Mass as a birthday celebration for our newborn King.

La Octava de Navidad

El otro día, mi sobrino de seis años vio un anuncio del juguete más nuevo, y por supuesto, él lo tenía que tener. Le preguntó a su mamá si compraría el juguete, pero ella respondió, “tal vez para Navidad”. Insatisfecho con la respuesta, respondió: “¡Es Navidad, mamá! Es el mes de la Navidad, así que yo debería poder hacerlo”.

En lo más profundo, todos queremos extender una fiesta o una celebración de cumpleaños. Es común escuchar a la gente bromas sobre su mes de cumpleaños o la semana de cumpleaños. Lo mismo sucede en la Navidad. Hay algo que la persona humana intuye acerca de una fiesta especial que no puede ser contenida en un día. La Iglesia estaría de acuerdo en que las fiestas especiales como la Navidad y la Pascua no pueden ser contenidas en un día. La celebración se desborda a ocho días de celebración. De ahí el término “octava” que significa “ocho”.

Desafortunadamente, la sociedad secular comienza a celebrar la Navidad el día después del Día de Acción de Gracias. Esta intención no es maliciosa, y la gente quiere extender la celebración, pero la celebración más importante debe venir del día de la Navidad y los siete días que siguen. No queremos perder la fuerza para cuando llegue la verdadera temporada de Navidad.

A los ojos de la Iglesia, Ella celebra el día de Navidad durante ocho días en celebración solemne. Mientras que la mayoría de la gente celebra menos, la Iglesia todavía exalta al niño Cristo. En el espíritu de la Iglesia, esta gran fiesta de la redención no debe limitarse a un solo día, sino que debe continuar durante toda una semana. No podemos impresionar a nuestra alma el gran misterio de la Navidad en un solo día. Toma tiempo reflexionar y dejar que el gran misterio se hunda en nuestra alma y entendimiento.

Mientras que esta celebración por ocho días ayuda a una persona a entrar en el misterio de Cristo que viene al mundo, el octavo día de esta octava se concluye con una solemnidad especial. La Navidad es acerca del niño Cristo que viene al mundo, pero recordamos el recipiente y cómo Él vino a nosotros a través de María. Por lo tanto, el 1^{ro} de enero, el octavo día y la conclusión de la octava, la Iglesia celebra la Solemnidad de María, Madre de Dios.

Mientras todos bromeamos sobre nuestra semana de cumpleaños sabiendo que no nos lo merecemos, Cristo merece una semana de celebración. Esto es exactamente lo que la Iglesia hace para alegrarse del cumpleaños de Jesús y termina con la celebración de su Madre. Para esta Octava de Navidad, asegúrense de mantener el fervor de la celebración con la familia y los amigos y traten de asistir a la Misa como una celebración de cumpleaños para nuestro recién nacido Rey.


