JOURNEY TOWARD GOD

In our celebration of the Epiphany, two interwoven themes are present in the readings today. God is beginning something new, and God gathers all of humanity to participate. For Isaiah, God's bright light, manifested in the people of Israel, attracts and summons people from many nations to Jerusalem. In the letter to the Ephesians, God's grace makes the Gentiles co-heirs and co-partners in the gospel. Matthew tells the story of the fulfillment of God's promises to Israel through the birth of Jesus, and simultaneously leading foreigners to share in these same promises. With the birth of Jesus, God chose a particular people, in a particular time and place, to enter most directly into the human story. Today's readings teach that God did this in order to gather all people, all cultures, into unity with God. Like the magi, we are drawn into a journey toward God, becoming co-partners in God's work. Con el nacimiento de Jesús, Dios eligió a un pueblo determinado, en un tiempo y lugares específicos, para entrar directamente en la historia de la humanidad. Las lecturas de hoy enseñan que Dios lo hizo para reunir a todos los pueblos, a todas las culturas, en la unidad con Dios. Mary Mother of God

January 1st is the eighth and final day of the Christmas Octave and we celebrate the beautiful Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. This feast has been celebrated in honor of Mary as early as the fourth century and there is major basilica in Rome dedicated to her.

As Catholics, we know Mary is our mother because when Christ was dying on the Cross, he gave his mother to John and the whole world. In our prayers and petitions, we turn to her for help and intercession to her Son. Her Son, Jesus Christ, has the same divine nature as God, and therefore, not only can we call her our mother, but the mother of God. Sometimes other people do not feel it is appropriate to say God has a mother because it makes him sound inferior, but this is not problem to Christ.

When Christ uses the title “Father” to refer to God, this has a motherly connection. The term “father” supposes there is a mother and a child. To be a father means there must be a son or daughter and a mother. For example, a newly married man and woman are not called mother and father until their first child. After their first child, even if the child passes away, they will always be a mother and father. After Christ died, Mary did not cease being a mother. Thus, when Christ says, “I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God” (Jn. 20:17), by the very title he uses, he is supposing there is a mother. Christ refers to God as ‘Father,’ and this supposes he also has a mother.

If Jesus Christ is God in the Flesh, as we believe, there is no way to deny that Mary is the mother of God. Mary gave birth to the Flesh of Christ, but Jesus does not separate his human flesh from his divine nature. This is why Mary is mother of the divine and human nature of Christ. As Catholics, we do not shy away in fear of this great mystery, we elevate it and celebrate it on this eight day of the Christmas octave.

María Madre de Dios

El 1^{ro} de Enero es el octavo y último día de la Octava de Navidad y celebramos la hermosa Solemnidad de María, la Santa Madre de Dios. Esta fiesta se ha celebrado en honor a María ya en el siglo IV y hay una gran basílica en Roma dedicada a ella.

Como católicos, sabemos que María es nuestra madre porque cuando Cristo estaba muriendo en la Cruz, le dio su madre a Juan y al mundo entero. En nuestras oraciones y peticiones, acudimos a ella en busca de ayuda e intercesión con su Hijo. Su Hijo, Jesucristo, tiene la misma naturaleza divina que Dios, y por lo tanto, no solo podemos llamarla nuestra madre, sino la madre de Dios. A veces, otras personas no sienten que sea apropiado decir que Dios tiene una madre porque eso lo hace parecer inferior, pero esto no es un problema para Cristo.

Cuando Cristo usa el título “Padre” para referirse a Dios, esto tiene una conexión maternal. El término “padre” supone que hay una madre y un hijo. Ser padre significa que debe haber un hijo o una hija y una madre. Por ejemplo, un hombre y una mujer recién casados no se denominan madre y padre hasta que tienen su primer hijo. Después de su primer hijo, incluso si el niño fallece, siempre serán madre y padre. Después de la muerte de Cristo, María no dejó de ser madre. Así, cuando Cristo dice: “Subo a mi Padre, que es Padre de ustedes; a mi Dios, que es Dios de ustedes.” (Jn. 20:17), por el mismo título que usa, está suponiendo que hay una madre. Cristo se refiere a Dios como “Padre”, y esto supone que él también tiene una madre.

Si Jesucristo es Dios en carne, como creemos, no hay forma de negar que María es la madre de Dios. María dio a luz a la Carne de Cristo, pero Jesús no separa su carne humana de su naturaleza divina. Por eso María es madre de la naturaleza divina y humana de Cristo. Como católicos, no rehuimos el miedo a este gran misterio, lo exaltamos y celebramos en este octavo día de la octava navideña.

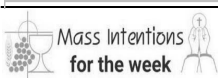
